GOATS REGULATIONS OF GOAT COMPETITION

301. The Regulations appearing in this Schedule form part of the General Regulations and conditions of entry to an event at the Royal Melbourne Show. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these Regulations, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES

302. Entries in the Goat competition must be received by the RASV Administration Offices, Melbourne Showgrounds, Epsom Road, Ascot Vale, Victoria 3032 by no later than 5.00pm on Friday 25 July 2008. All entries must be accompanied by the applicable fee and health status declaration form.

303. The onus is entirely on the Exhibitor to submit particulars on time. There will be no reminder from RAS staff.

ENTRY FEES

304. Entry Fees for Goat breeds are as follows (straw inclusive):

305. This entry fee entitles the Exhibitor to enter the animal in all eligible classes. Please specify selected classes on enclosed Entry Form.

CATALOGUES

306. Each exhibitor is to pre purchase one catalogue for \$5.00 with their initial entry. Upon arrival at the Showgrounds you will be given your catalogue, which will be included in their exhibitor pack. Additional catalogues can be purchased from the Superintendent's Office.

TRUCK PARKING

307. Parking for trucks and floats is available in the VRC Racecourse. Apply by completing the relevant section on the Entry Form and forward the fee with the competition Entry Fee.

310. There is to be no camping in the VRC Truck Park under any circumstances.

311. Any vehicle, including trucks, stock transports, trailers, and horse floats, located on the Showgrounds, or any area leased by the RASV, shall be at the sole risk of the owner. The RASV accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage, including loss or damage caused by negligence of the RASV, its officers, employees, or agents to any vehicle, or the contents of any vehicle, located on the RASV's property or in the area leased by the RASV.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS

312. All Goat Exhibitors are to comply with the following arrival and departure timings, unless otherwise notified directly by the RASV Goat Event Coordinator.

313. Arrival and Departure times are as follows:

Dairy Goats:

Arrival: Wednesday 17 September 2008 between 4.00pm and 7.00pm.

Departure: Sunday 21 September 2008 between 6.30pm and 8.00pm.

Boer and Angora Goats:

Arrival: Friday 19 September 2008 between 5.00am and 8.00am

(Boer Goat Exhibitors are welcome to arrive on Thursday night if it is more convenient. This needs to be by arrangement with the Event Coordinator.)

Departure: Sunday 21 September 2008 between 4.00pm and 8.00pm

314. Priority may be given to Exhibitors that have considerable distance to travel. PERIOD OF EXHIBITION

Dairy Goats:

315. All Dairy goats are required to be in their correct pens by 8.00pm on Wednesday 17 September 2008 prior to strip out.

Boer Goats:

316. All Boer goats are required to be in their correct pens by 12 noon on Friday 19 September 2008.

STORAGE LOCKERS

317. Storage Locker prices are \$55.00 (GST inc.) of which \$20.00 is a key deposit. On return of Locker Key a refund will be issued. Due to limited Storage Lockers, we reserve the right to limit allocation in an effort to accommodate all Exhibitors.

BEDDING

318. No bedding other than straw may be used in pens.

319. For the convenience of Exhibitors, fodder merchants will attend the Showgrounds for the purpose of accepting orders for stock foods, etc and the delivery of food stocks must be made before 8.00am each day during the Show.

STOCK ATTENDANT PASSES

320. A Confirmation of Entries will be issued prior to the Show.

321. The Confirmation of Entries document must be produced at the gate, when it will admit the Exhibitor and Exhibits on to the Showgrounds. It must be retained, and again produced when the Exhibit leaves the Showgrounds. Stock Attendant Passes will be issued by the Superintendent at his office on the Showgrounds once Exhibits have been penned.

322. Stock Attendant Passes will be issued according to the following formula:

One Stock Attendant Pass for every Exhibitor.

CLEANLINESS OF PENS

323. Mucking out of pens is to be carried out between 8.00pm and 7.00am. These times will be strictly enforced.

324. Exhibitors must keep the pens allotted to their animals clean and give proper attention to their stock throughout the Show. Cleaning of pens occupied by Exhibits must be completed before 7.00am each day.

ADVERTISING

325. Exhibitors are permitted to display cards over the pens allotted to them stating that an animal is for private sale. These cards are not to exceed 30cm x 25cm. No other advertisement or notices (except by permission of the RASV) are permitted on or in any stalls or buildings.

326. Each Exhibitor is permitted to display one sign 60cm x 120cm in size provided that such sign carries only the stud name, address, telephone number, facsimile number, e-mail address and website address.

SMOKING

327. Smoking and naked flames are at all times prohibited in Lockers and Pavilions. **REGISTRATION**

328. All goats entered in this Section must be registered in a herd book recognised by the RASV or recorded in the appendix sections of a herd book recognised by the RASV.

329. All Boer Goats must be registered with the Boer Goat Breeder's Association of Australia (BGBAA) and must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor at date of entry.

330. For particulars of registration of Dairy Goats in the Goat Herd Book of Australia, apply to The Secretary, P.O. Box 9048. Traralgon 3844

331. For particulars of registration of Angora Goats in the Herd Book, apply to, Mohair Australia Limited, P.O. Box 22, Narrandera, NSW, 2700.

332. For particulars of registration in the Boer Goat Breeders' Association of Australia Ltd, apply to The Secretary, 235 Schoolhouse Lane, Tallarook Vic, 3659.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

333. All Goat entries must be accompanied by the applicable Goat Health Status Declaration Form signed by the Exhibitor or authorised agent and a Government Veterinary Officer.

334. The 2008 Goat Competitions will be conducted under the guidelines as set out in the Johne's Disease Market Assurance Program (GoatMAP).

CAPRINE ARTHRITIS ENCEPHALITIS (CAE)

335. Dairy Goats will not be permitted to enter the Showgrounds unless Exhibitors provide a Veterinary Certificate to the effect that the goats to be exhibited:

a) Are from a CAE accredited free herd or,

b) Have had a least one negative ELISA test after 1 January 2008, and show no clinical signs of the virus or,

c) Have had at least one (1) negative test after 1 January 2008 for Johne's Disease and show no clinical signs (for goats over 12 months).

These certificates must be submitted to the RASV office by Friday 25 July 2008 or the relevant entries will be cancelled.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SCHEME (NLIS)

336. All goats including goats in the carcass competition, born after the January 1 2006 are required to have an NLIS tag attached when attending the Show.

UNSAFE EXHIBITS

337. If, in its absolute discretion the RASV determines any Exhibit or Exhibits to be dangerous, for any reason whatsoever, the RASV may by notice to the Exhibitor require the animal, or animals concerned, to be forthwith removed from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animals and failing such removal by him within the time prescribed by the RASV, the RASV may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the RASV.

IN MILK AND DRY CLASSES

338. A fee will be charged for each Doe competing in the milk test for the testing of the samples.

339. A Doe entered as "in milk" can be transferred to a "dry" or un-kidded class, whichever is applicable, if she has not kidded prior to judging day, and vice versa.

340. Does in milk must be at the Showgrounds on Wednesday 17 September 2008 to be fully milked out and stripped dry at 8.00pm on Wednesday 17 September 2008, in the presence of the Stewards or whomever they may appoint. The owner or his/her representative must be in attendance when females are being stripped dry.

341. The procedures for conducting the 24-hour Milk Production Tests are as recommended by the Dairy Goat Society of Australia.

342. Exhibitors in the 24-hour Milk Production classes are required to advise the Stewards of:

a) The number of lactations completed by each Doe.

b) Last date of kidding or abortion.

343. Judges have the absolute right to order any Doe competing for Championships to be milked dry before finally awarding the prizes.

SUCKLED KIDS

344. Notwithstanding General Regulation 7.5, kids not entered for competition will be permitted in the Showgrounds on the provision they are actually being suckled by mothers entered for competition.

345. Exhibitors may provide their own mesh or similar, to create their own kid areas within their penning areas, prior to the 24 hour Milk Test and judging day, if required, for kids brought in suckling their dams.

INSPECTION OF EXHIBITS

346. Each breed society or association shall put forward nominations for Inspector appointments for their breed and these nominations will be considered by the RASV.

347. Every animal exhibited in the Goat section will be subject to inspection carried out by an Inspector appointed by the RASV.

348. Without prejudice to any other applicable regulations, if the relevant Inspector determines, or the relevant Inspectors unanimously determine that any animal entered for competition:

a) is not true to type; or

 b) is not of sufficient merit as to be worthy of exhibition in the class or classes for which it is entered; or

c) has not been adequately prepared for the Show, or

d) bears any marking brand or tattoo inconsistent with either the markings brand or tattoo disclosed in the relevant Entry Form or any marking brand or tattoo not in accordance with the records of the relevant Breed Society.

then such animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show and the RASV may by notice to the Exhibitor, require the animal to be forthwith removed from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animal and failing such removal by him within the time prescribed by the RASV, the RASV may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall become by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the RASV.

349. Exhibitors are required to have their stock attended and in readiness for inspection on request.

350. Without prejudice, the determination of the Inspectors or of the Veterinary Surgeons on any matter shall be subject only to appeal to the Chief Steward in the Goat section, who shall make such determinations and directions as he thinks fit, which determinations and directions shall be final and shall not be called into question in any proceedings or in any manner whatsoever. The Inspector, Veterinary Surgeons or Chief Steward shall not be required to furnish to the Exhibitor any reasons for their determination or directions or to give to the Exhibitor any right to be heard on any matter in question.

351. Any animal entered, which can be proved to the satisfaction of the RASV to have received hormones, shall be disqualified. The decision or determination of the RASV shall be final and shall not be called into question in any proceeding or in any manner whatsoever.

JUDGING

352. The following Regulations shall be read subject to Regulations 10.1 through to 11.7 inclusive of the General Regulations.

a). Judging dates of Exhibits are as follows:

b). A ribbon may be awarded, at the Judges discretion, to place getters in all classes.

c). Exhibitors of goats shall be present at the appropriate Judging Ring at least 15 minutes prior to the time specified in the timetable for judging to take place. They must have their Exhibits ready for judging, and enter the Judging Ring immediately upon request by the appropriate steward(s).

d). Attendants leading goats in the Judging Ring or on parade must wear uniform white coats and the Exhibit number of the goat. Exhibitors must collect these numbers from the Superintendent's Office.

e). Persons in charge of Exhibits at or in the Judging Ring shall not address the Judge unless authorised by the Steward in Charge or the Judge himself.

353. After judging is completed, only prize-winning goats are permitted to take part in parades. All prize-winning Dairy goats must be taken out on parade, in accordance with the printed program. Prize-winning Angoras may also be paraded provided they can be suitably led.

354. In any parade prior to judging, goats are to be paraded according to the following formula:

355. No ribbons will be permitted on the Exhibits on parade, except those won during the 2008 Royal Melbourne Show.

356. Persons in charge of Exhibits must in no circumstance leave their Exhibits unattended at or in the Judging Ring.

RUGGING

357. Exhibits must not be rugged during the hours the Show is open to the public. Exhibitors will be liable to a fine of \$50.00 for every infringement of this regulation. **PRIZES**

359. Judging is subject to General Regulation 10. The Judge is under no obligation to award the prizes listed in the table where he considers in his absolute discretion that such prize or prizes are not to be awarded.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

360. Prize money as stated in the relevant Prize Schedule, does not include GST. GST will be added to the Prize money for Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and have provided an ABN Number.

Judging will take place during the Judging of the Dairy Goat Classes. Entrants must be over 18 years of age. Eligible entrants must parade a minimum of 3 exhibits for the duration of the Dairy Goat Judging. (S001)

Points will be awarded for the following items:

- 1. Presentation of goat and handler.
- 2. Knowledge and control of animal being shown. Account will be taken of difficulties a competitor may have in controlling an exhibit.
- 3. Knowledge of ringcraft.
- 4. Attention to instructions received from Stewards and Judge.

JUNIOR MOST SUCCESSFUL HANDLER

This Special Award will be given to the Junior Most Successful Handler in a class to be held in the Dairy Goat Judging Ring. (S002)

1. Presentation of goat and handler.

2. Knowledge and control of animal being shown.

- 3. Knowledge of ringcraft.
- 4. Attention to instructions received from Stewards and Judge.

GOAT CARCASE COMPETITION

Judge:

David Booth (Hoof) Dr Bruce McGregor (Hook)

The objective of conducting a Goat Carcase competition is to identify the most consistent consignments of meat goats that meet market specifications with the highest eye muscle area and the leanest carcases.

The Boer Goat Breeders Association of Australia Victorian Branch (BGBAA Vic) has developed, through consultation with The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria, the Royal Melbourne Show Goat Carcase Competition, which comprises both Hoof and Hook components.

The competition is conducted by BGBAA Vic. All entrants are to comply with both the regulations of this competition, the Regulations of the Goat Competitions and the General Regulations.

In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these Regulations, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise.

REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES FOR THE BGBAA CARCASE COMPETITION

361. Goat Carcase \$25 per pen of three (GST inc.) for Members \$40 per pen of three (GST inc.) for Non-members

362. Any goat normally sold for meat can be entered. They do not have to be registered or have any special breeding.

363. Exhibits may be male or female.

364. Male goats entered in the Capretto class can be left entire as bucks.

365. Male goats entered in Kid or Chevon classes must be castrated and sold as wethers.

366. The animals will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle area (EMA) Too much fat will be penalised. Animals may be moved to another class depending on their weight.

367. Animals must be free from drench or other chemical or drug residue at the time of slaughter.

368. Animals do not need to be nominated individually when entered, only the breeder's name and number of entries (in groups of 3). Animals will need to be tagged to identify the animal for the hook competition.

369. Animals will be eligible for two separate competitions. The "hoof" component, judged at the Royal Melbourne Show, and the "hook" component judged at the abattoir.

370. There will be two separate judges. The judges' decision will be final.

371. All Exhibits entered will be sold and transported to the abattoir. If Exhibitors wish to keep the carcases after slaughter they will have to pay the kill and transport charge.

372. In order for Exhibits to be slaughtered, and therefore eligible for competition, Exhibitors must provide a National Goat Vendor Declaration, as they are being sold for meat.

373. All exhibits entered are required to have a NLIS tag attached when attending the Show.

374. Exhibitors will comply with the Health Regulations, as listed in Regulation 333 of the Regulations for Goat Competition listed in this Schedule, including Veterinarian certification for Johnes Disease.

375. All Animals to be entered in a pen of three, which equates to one entry.
