Trophies and Awards

“GOLDEN AXE” GRAND AGGREGATE TROPHY

The competitor gaining the highest number of points shall be declared the winner.

The “Golden Axe” Grand Aggregate Trophy will be awarded to the competitor who receives the greatest number of points from all finals except Under 15, Under 18, Women’s and Team events.

The points awarded to each competitor are as follows:

- 1st: 5 points
- 2nd: 3 points
- 3rd: 2 points
- 4th: 1 point

In two person events, the points shall be shared. In the event of a tie, the winner will be declared on a count back of the most wins in finals. If a tie still exists, a similar count back will take place in previous heats.

CHAMPION AXEMAN TROPHY

The competitor gaining the highest number of points shall be declared the winner.

The Champion Axeman Trophy will be awarded to the competitor who receives the highest points in all Championship events.

The points awarded to each competitor are as follows:

- 1st: 5 points
- 2nd: 3 points
- 3rd: 2 points
- 4th: 1 point

In the event of a tie, the winner will be declared on a count back of the most wins in finals. If a tie still exists, a similar count back will take place in previous heats.

HANDICAP AGGREGATE TROPHY

The competitor gaining the highest number of

points shall be declared the winner.

The Handicap Aggregate Trophy will be awarded to the competitor who receives the greatest number of points in all open Handicap events.

The points awarded to each competitor are as follows:

- 1st: 5 points
- 2nd: 3 points
- 3rd: 2 points
- 4th: 1 point

In two person events, the points shall be shared. In the event of a tie, the winner will be declared on a count back of the most wins in finals. If a tie still exists, a similar count back will take place in previous heats.

UNDER 21 AGGREGATE TROPHY

Open to all competitors under 21 years of age. The competitor gaining the highest number of points shall be declared the winner.

The Under 21 Aggregate Trophy will be awarded to the competitor under the age of 21 who receives the highest number of points in finals (or heats for classes where no under-21-year-olds progress to the finals), excluding double handed sawing or team events.

The points awarded to each competitor will be based on their placing relative to other competitors who are under 21, as follows:

- Highest placing under-21-year-old: 5 points
- 2nd highest placing under-21-year-old: 3 points
- 3rd highest placing under-21-year-old: 2 points
- 4th highest placing under-21-year-old: 1 point

Trophies and Awards

THE “TAS PICKETT” MEMORIAL TROPHY – TEAMS RACE

Each team to comprise of 7 competitors, including a captain.

Melbourne Royal welcomes the opportunity to conduct the Victoria versus ‘The Rest’ Teams Race this year. Teams will be announced at the Melbourne Royal Show and posted in the Competitors Tent beside the Woodchop Pavilion.

Events

Championships are limited to the best 12 competitors by handicap, unless otherwise stated.

With the exception of Tree Felling, if an event has eight or fewer competitors, all competitors will go straight to the final, and only the top three places will receive cash prizes.

Events with more than eight competitors but less than 36 competitors will have heats and a final. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in the final will receive cash prizes (amounts vary by competition), and 4th–6th place will receive a refund of their entry fee.

STANDING BLOCK AND UNDERHAND

Handicap events with more than 36 entrants will be split into two divisions with separate heats and finals. Allocation to divisions will be decided by handicap. Cash prizes will be divided evenly between the divisions. 4th–6th place will not be awarded prizes.

OPEN TREE FELLING EVENTS

No trimming of board holes will be permitted. Competitors must put three spring boards above each other and cut out the front scarf, then descend removing the three spring boards to the ground and put the same three spring boards in on the other side and cut out the back scarf. (Logs must not be cut off from one side.) Any competitor chopping in a previously cut board hole will be disqualified.

The events are limited to experienced axemen and they must state on the entry form whether they are left- or right-handed.

EVENT 1: TREE FELLING CHAMPIONSHIP (300MM)

Axemen nominating in this championship event must enter the Tree Felling handicap event to qualify. Restricted to the best eight axemen by handicap.

OPEN HARD HITTING EVENTS

The event to be completed by each contestant within 90 secs or at the discretion of the Melbourne Royal. In the event of a dead heat, time will be the deciding factor.

The check starter is not permitted to inspect logs before full time allowance for each chop has expired. During the chop the time keeper may call the elapsed time of 15 second intervals. Standard Axes are to be used in these events, and are not to exceed 3kg overall weight and 180mm cutting edge. The Axes shall be weighed prior to the commencement of the event.

OPEN SAWING EVENTS

AAA Special Regulations 123 and 124 apply. The saw may rest on the top of the log to start. No saw cuts permitted prior to start. These events are open to any style of crosscut saw. The bottom of the log will be 500mm above ground level.

Competitors in Double Handed Events must enter individually for those Events. Nominations for pairs must be lodged with the Handicapper at the time of the Show.
