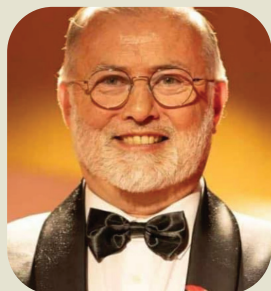

Christian was born in the sixties in Lyon, an area of France which is famous for its foods and wine. He currently resides in Villeparisis, France. Previously, Christian was a breeder of Dobermanns and was very involved in the breed club. Today he is involved with Basenjies and Rhodesian Ridgebacks, having bred some excellent specimens who have done very well in the showrings of Europe, breeding under the “Out of Africa” affix.

Christian first became an FCI judge in 2000 for the Dobermann breed. Step by step, he attained his licences for other breeds and at the end of 2017, he became an all-rounder. Christian has judged in many countries across Europe, together with South Africa, North America, Russia, and Indonesia. Christian has judged at many prominent shows in Europe, including two World Dog Shows (France and Italy), Eurasia, EDS Hungary, and several Nordic Shows.

He has also judged at a number of breed specialties in Australia between 2009 and 2016 (Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Papillon, German Spitz, French Bulldog and Basenji) in NSW, and he judged at the 2022 Melbourne Royal.

Christian has the honour to be involved in the training of judges for many French Breed Clubs, being selected to be a trainer of judges by over 50 breed clubs. He has been involved with the French Dobermann and Basenji Clubs and is a past President of the French Rhodesian Ridgeback Club.

Melbourne Royal is delighted to welcome Christian back to judge breeds and Best in Show as he was so well received on his last visit, being a talented, enthusiastic and professional judge who worked so well with exhibitors and his breeds.

### **ELINA HAAPANIEMI (FINLAND)**

**Group 6B (Utility – Balance of Breeds) and Group Specials**  
**BEST PUPPY IN SHOW**

Elina has been involved in the world of dogs since age 12. Her journey began with the Rottweiler, but her breeding work focused upon the Pyrenean Mountain Dog under the kennel name 'Aspenella'. Additionally, she has owned Shiba Inu. She has been an active member of the Finnish Rottweiler Club, founder and Chairperson on the Finnish Pyrenean Mountain Dog Club and currently Honorary President of the Finnish Pyrenean Breeds Club. Over her time as a breeder and exhibitor, Elina's dogs have reached Best in Show level, with World and European Winners.

Elina's judging journey began in 1978, gaining a license for her initial breed, Rottweilers, in 1979. Over the years, she has gained licenses for some or all breeds in FCI Groups 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10, together with Best in Show.

Over many years, Elina has judged widely across the globe, with great admiration and positive comments from the exhibitors. Her judging has centred across Nordic and Europe countries, together with Australia, New Zealand, Canada, South Africa and the United Kingdom. Testament to Elina's reputation is the large number of breeds in which she has awarded CCs in the UK and having judged at the famous Crufts on 6 occasions. She has judged groups at both large UK Championship Shows and Crufts and Best in Show at the National Working and Pastoral Breeds UK.

Elina has also had the honour to judge at World Dog Shows in Finland (2014 and 2025) and Sweden (2008) and she will judge at the Swedish European Dog Show (2026). Her list of Specialty appointments across numerous countries is large, covering breeds such as Rottweilers, Samoyeds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Newfoundlands, Leonbergers, Irish Wolfhounds, Australian Shepherds, Maremmas, Boxers, Schipperke, Briards and Bernese Mountain Dogs.

As an experienced judge, exhibitor and administrator, Elina has given a great deal back to Finnish Cynology. She has held positions as a member of the Finnish Judges' Sub Committee, the Chairperson of the Finnish Kennel Club Breed Standards Committee and she was awarded the Silver Medal of Honour by the Finnish Kennel Club for her valued contribution.

In 2014 Elina adjudicated at Melbourne Royal. She was extremely well received by exhibitors, having a strong focus upon breed type in her judging, together with demonstrating a very respectful approach to both the exhibitors and their dogs.

Aside from dogs, Elina's hobbies and interests include travelling, reading, classical music and especially collecting older dog books. Melbourne Royal looks forward to welcoming Elina back to the 2026 Show.

Andrzej has always had a deep interest in dogs, so the development of a passion for breeding, exhibiting and judging dogs was a natural progression.

Andrzej's first show dog was a Polish Lowland Sheepdog in 1982. Whilst not breeding extensively, he produced 3 World Winners, 3 Specialty Winners, and successful dogs who were exported to other continents and countries. His most successful home bred dog was the sire of over 30 Champions in 7 countries.

Since 1990, Andrzej has bred and exhibited Golden Retrievers. His breeding program again has been limited, but the Oligarchia Kennel has produced more than 50 Champions in 9 countries which is no mean feat! Andrzej has also owned and exhibited Boxers and was Secretary of the Polish Boxer Club for 4 years, and President of the Retriever Club of Poland for 15 years.

Andrzej began his judging career in 1996. He judges FCI Groups 1,2,5,6,7,8 and 9. He has judged extensively across the globe. This includes many European Countries, World Dog Shows, European Dog Shows, National Winner Shows and Breed Specialties including Golden Retrievers, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, French Bulldogs, Boxers, Australian Shepherds, American Akitas, Shiba Inu, Rottweilers, Schnauzers, Beagles and Pugs. Andrzej visited Australia once, some 7 years ago, to judge a Golden Retriever Specialty.

Testament to Andrzej's commitment and standing, he is President of the Polish Kennel Club Judges Committee.

Andrzej is a passionate and experienced judge across many groups, with a deep passion for the sport of dogs. He is widely known for his excellent ring manner and consideration and respect for both exhibitors and the dogs who enter his ring.

Tijana began her judging journey in 2003 and was recently elevated to All Rounder – something she is very proud of as she is a second generation All Rounder. She has judged widely in National, International and Specialty events. During this time Kerin has contributed to the development of her dogs, and the breed, by importing both dogs and semen to further enhance the Suliman Kennel.

Suliman has won two National Specialty BIS awards, along with numerous Specialty BIS and All Breeds BIS awards at many of Australia's most prestigious and largest all breed shows. This includes twice winning BIS at Adelaide Royal, 8 Royal Best in Groups, and Puppy in Show at Sydney Royal.

Ten years ago, the Suliman Kennel also added Chinese Cresteds to the show team and they have also owned, shown and/or lived with Whippets, Beagles, Standard Long Haired Dachshunds and English Cocker Spaniels.

Kerin was a founding member for the Saluki Club of South Australia, serving in various positions on the Afghan Hound Club of SA and the Colomeke All Breeds Kennel Club.

Kerin's judging journey began in 2000 and she became a Dogs Australia & FCI All Breeds Judge in 2018. Kerin believes she continues to learn and further develop her judging skills every time she enters the ring.

She has been very honoured to be invited to judge in Russia, Spain, USA, Canada, New Zealand, Thailand and all states of Australia. A highlight included the well-known Monografica circuit in Spain, including judging National Specialties for Afghans and Whippets and then overall BIS.

Testament to her recognition in our region, Kerin judged the NSW French Bulldog Specialty, Celebration of the Best in the West, Bathurst Royal, and the Tasmania Contest of Champions, together with judging in every Australian State and New Zealand.

Kerin's other contributions to the dog world include having served as a Councillor on the Dog SA Board of Councillors, member of the Conformation Judges Training Scheme as Hound Group Leader and previously as Assistant Leader of the Toy Group. She also served on the Disciplinary Panel for Dogs SA.

## Entry Closing Date

Entries to the Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show held at the 2026 Melbourne Royal Show close at 5pm, Tuesday 4 August 2026, excluding Baby Puppy entries which close at 5pm, Tuesday 18 August 2026.

## General and Special Regulations

The Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show is conducted under the General and Special Regulations of Melbourne Royal and the Rules and Regulations of Dogs Victoria form part of the conditions of entry.

Special Regulations override any General Regulations where a conflict occurs.

Entries for Conformation (all classes), Sweepstakes (all classes) and Action Dog (all classes) can be made via the online entry system.

Simply click onto the Melbourne Royal Show button and then select 'Dogs' from the drop down menu. If entering using the Melbourne Royal online entry system please ensure that you read all user instructions, terms and conditions prior to entering. Payment can be made by either Visa or MasterCard.

## Junior Showmanship

Junior competitors will be required to provide their name, an email address and a mobile phone number to enter. Entries can be completed until 3pm on the day that you wish to compete. If you wish to compete on multiple days, you will need to enter for each day.

Registration opportunities will be available at the Administration office (located in Pavilion 19).

If you are competing on multiple days, you will need to collect new numbers each day you are competing.

## Breed Specialty

Entries for Breed Club Specialty Show Competitions are managed by each participating Breed Club. Exhibitors interested in entering their Breed Specialty are requested to contact their Breed Club and lodge their entry with that organisation, who will then organise your entry.

# Conditions, Rules and Regulations Pertaining to *Entering and Competing*

Exhibitors are advised to read all of the regulations and conditions that pertain to entering and participating at the 2026 Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show. Regulations and conditions can be located under entries at [www.melbournroyal.com.au/dogs](http://www.melbournroyal.com.au/dogs). Exhibitors will be required to comply in full with the regulations and conditions pertaining to entry.

All dogs must be benched from 9am until 5pm.

The age of all dogs is to be calculated as at the first day of CONFORMATION judging (Friday 25 September 2026).

All dogs shall be entered in only one Ordinary Class. (Sweepstakes classes are not considered Ordinary Classes) All dogs entered in Baby Puppy, Puppy, and Champion Sweepstakes must also be entered in one Ordinary Class (exception made only for those exhibits entered into Neutered or Veteran Sweepstakes classes).

## **Breed Club Specialty Show Competitions**

Breed Club Specialty Show Competitions are held in conjunction with the Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show.

Exhibitors wishing to enter their Breed Specialty are to contact their Breed Club for entry details. The participating Breed Club is responsible for managing all entries for the Breed Specialty Shows.

## **Junior Showmanship Conditions of Entry**

Entries for Junior Showmanship Competition are required to be lodged on the day up until 3pm on the day of heat judging. See the 'How to Enter' section on page 15 of this schedule.

Entrants can continue to compete until qualified to compete in the finals (eligible if winner of 1st place in a heat). The winner of each heat will be invited to return to compete in the final on General Specials Day. Should the winner of a heat be unable to return on General Specials Day, the second place winner will then compete in the finals. This must be arranged and confirmed by both parties with the Program Coordinator by 5pm on the day of the heat.

Exhibit used must be entered and shown in its breed class on the day it is handled in the Junior Showmanship Competition. Judges for heats will be announced prior to commencement of judging each day. Judge for the finals may be a member of the Judging Panel and will be announced prior to the judging of the finals.

The finals for the Junior Showmanship Competition will occur after Group Specials and before Best In Show judging on General Specials Day.

## Judging Guidelines

### Baby Puppy Classes

At the conclusion of breed judging in each ring, Best Baby Puppy of each breed will compete for Baby Puppy of the ring. Then the Best Baby Puppy of each ring will compete for Best Baby Puppy of the day. On General Specials day, only the Best Baby Puppy of each day will return to compete for Best Baby Puppy in Show.

### ANKC Regulations

The ANKC has resolved that where a Royal Show only offers Best Puppy In Group/In Show and Best Exhibit In Group/In Show, then Group and Show placings shall apply. This type of judging does not necessarily produce the second, third and fourth best dogs in Group or Show, but rather the four best dogs in the ring from the Best Of Breed winners and, in the case of Best In Show, from the Group winners.



# Conformation

## General Specials Judging

Each Group will be judged in its entirety, in the same ring, in the order listed below. Judging will start with Best Exhibit in Group followed by Best Puppy in Group. Weather permitting, judging will take place outside on the Main Dog Judging Ring.

Judging will commence at 9am and the Groups will be judged in the following order: Group 2, Group 4, Group 6, Group 3, Group 1, Group 7, Group 5.

## Sequence of Judging

As required by the ANKC Regulations the sequence of judging Best Exhibit in Group and Best Exhibit in Show awards shall be in the following order:

1. Best Exhibit in Group, placed in order 4th, 3rd, 2nd, 1st
2. Best Puppy In Group
3. Best Baby Puppy In Show
4. Best Exhibit In Show, placed in order 2nd, 1st
5. Best Puppy In Show

## Best of Breed

The judging of Best Of Breed and Runner Up to Best Of Breed will be conducted at the completion of judging each breed daily, in the normal way; however, the Runner-Up Best Of Breed shall not be required to return on General Specials Day. If you are to return on General Specials Day, you will be supplied with one (1) general admission ticket to return on the day.

## Best Baby Puppy of the Day

The judging of Best Baby Puppy of the Day will be judged at the conclusion of all Breed judging on the day. Only Best Baby Puppy of the Day will be invited to return for judging of Best Baby Puppy in Show on General Specials Day. If you are to return on General Specials Day, you will be supplied with one (1) general admission ticket to return on the day.

## Best Exhibit in Group

Only exhibits that have won Best Of Breed shall be eligible to compete for Best Exhibit In Group awards 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th subject to the provisions of ANKC Regulations. The judge shall select eight dogs from the Best of Breed winners. The balance of the Group is excused. The judge will then select 4th, 3rd, 2nd and 1st in Group in that order.

## Puppy in Group

Only Best Puppy in Group award will be offered. Therefore, only puppies that have competed in Class 3 or Class 3A and have won Best Puppy of Breed are eligible to compete for Puppy In Group. The judge shall select four dogs from the puppy of breed winners. The balance of the puppies will be excused. From the four remaining, the judge will then select his/her Puppy in Group.

## Best Baby Puppy in Show

Only Best Baby Puppy in Show award will be offered, therefore, only Best Baby Puppy on the Day winners are eligible to compete for Best Baby Puppy in Show.

## Best Exhibit in Show

Only exhibits that have won Best Exhibit in Group shall be eligible to compete for Best Exhibit In Show awards 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th subject to the provisions of ANKC Regulations. The judge shall have the book marked in order of preference 1, 2, 3, 4. The microphone steward will announce, from the judge's book, the 4th BIS place-getter, which shall then proceed to the fourth peg and be presented with any awards. The same process is then followed for the 3rd place-getter, 2nd place-getter and Best in Show.

## Best Puppy in Show

Only Best Puppy in Show award will be offered, therefore, only Best Puppy in Group winners are eligible to compete for Best Puppy In Show.

## Breed Specialty Competitions

Breed Specialty Competitions are held in conjunction with the Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show. Exhibitors wishing to enter their Breed Specialty are to contact their Breed Club directly for entry details.

Starting time will be at the conclusion of judging in the allocated Judge's ring, or soon thereafter.

Breed Clubs will be responsible for:

- Promotion of their own event;
- Management of entries and all aspects of administration;
- Production of all documentation required to be able to run their Specialty show on their allocated day. This includes the production of a catalogue, stewards sheets, allocation of exhibit numbers and all associated administration.
- Provide a ticket writer (for the documenting of results, creation of any certificates and marking the Catalogue etc.)
- Provision of all awards for the event and bringing them on the day;
- Option to hang one professional banner on the fence surrounding the allocated judging ring.

Melbourne Royal will be responsible for:

- Provision of VCA representative for the event;
- Provision of Melbourne Royal Stewards to run the event;
- Allocation of the officiating Judge. The Judge will be selected from the judging panel. The Judge will award trophies in the ring;
- Provision of place-markers for each judging ring.
