TO THE SUBSCRIBERS.

Ladies and Gentlemen-

Your Council have much pleasure in presenting the following report of the proceedings of the Society for the year 1910:---

Permanent Buildings and Works.

Quite a number of improvements and alterations have been effected during the year. In March, on the recommendation of the Works Committee, your Council resolved to re-grade the trotting track on the north side, to cause certain buildings in the Industrial Court to be removed in order to open up roadways to the new machinery ground, and to grade and brick the floors of the new pig pens, and provide them with proper drainage. Also to extend the roof of the pig shed eastwards, and to so construct it as to stop driving rain, to extend the poultry building 54 feet westwards, and to water a portion of the arena during summer by way of experiment. A contract of £585 5s. was accepted for these works, and they were carried out. Later on, another contract was let for new ladies' rooms (a very fine building) £1063 18s.; new closets, etc., £464 15s.; sewering, £155 10s.; forming roads and grading new machinery ground, £529; water service, £223; verandah, sheep shed, £44 19s. 6d.; drain and grading embankment, £10. A water jump was provided, and a number of minor improvements were effected-the cost for the year being £4110 14s. 9d., bringing the total expenditure on buildings, works and maintenance up to £68,745 2s. 4d.

The Exhibition.

The annual exhibition was held on the 30th and 31st August and 1st, 2nd, and 3rd September. The prize schedule was well revised and re-arranged, and a number of new classes were added. The entries reached the large total of 7610, being 902 in advance of last year's record number, so that a further record has been established—placing this Society's Show in the lead of all others in the Commonwealth. The gate money, including £401 2s. 6d. at the grand stand, amounted to £5889 12s., another record, being £1417 3s. in advance of the year before, and £7 4s. above the sum received for admission in 1906, the previous record year for gate money, which is always the Society's principal source of, revenue.

The subjoined table gives the number of exhibits in the several sections, along with those of the year before, for purposes of comparison.

Reviewing the exhibits in the order catalogued, the draught horses, which had increased by 58 last year, showed a further increase of 67, the total of 315 constituting a record, while the quality of the great bulk of the exhibits was of a high standard. Suffolk punches dropped down to five exhibits, an evidence that the breed, which has had representatives in Victoria for over 40 years, has not found favour with the public. Thoroughbreds increased to 10. and some good stallions were shown, but the section is still a somewhat weak one. As last year, three Arabs of fair type were exhibited. Trotters still further decreased in numbers, but there were some attractive exhibits. In roadsters, hackneys (breeding section), ponies, etc., the competition was much as last year. In the contests, comprising hunters, etc., there was an increased entry, and a water jump was added to the other attractions. Hackneys, carriage horses, etc., well maintained their average. In cattle the shorthorns showed a drop in numbers, and while very fine specimens of the breed are still exhibited, there is a diminution in numbers through many of the herds of long standing being broken up. Herefords were slightly

in increase and were of fine quality, while polled Angus, red polled, etc., were about as last year. South Devons showed an increase, and milking Shorthorns, which are a good deal favoured, well held their own. Ayrshires have increased to 329, and have definitely asserted their claim to be the principal dairy breed in Victoria. Jerseys showed an increase, and contained some animals of much merit, and very taking appearance. Guernseys were shown for the first time, and attracted much attention. Holsteins, after being exhibited for a good many years, have dropped out, while there was one Kerry and ten Dexter Kerriesa breed not seen in the yards for some years and of which the representatives were greatly admired. Dairy cattle and fat cattle were much on their usual lines. The British breeds of sheep were very well represented, the exhibition in this department, all through, being a very fine one, with Lincolns still the leading breed. In swine, the increase from 188 to 441 was phenomenal, overtaxing the accommodation, of which, however, eventually all that was necessary was provided, and the section was about the most talked of in the Show. In poultry, also, there was a very large increase, the "Royal" poultry section now being regarded as one of the best of shows. In dogs, as well, there was an increase. Carriages, buggies, etc., and harness and saddlery had larger entries. In farm produce no noticeable progress is shown, the season in which the exhibition is held being unfavourable to a large display. In State schools' produce there was little change, and the "district exhibits" fell off to two, while the State Schools and Agricultural High and Technical Schools were on the same lines as last year. Dairy produce was, as before, in quantity, and the exhibits were of a most superior quality. In wines the competition showed a falling off, growers not coming forward as exhibitors as they might be expected to do. Fruits, etc., and agricultural exhibits were as last year, the former being, like the farm produce, not easy to obtain in September. A safety chaffcutter competition for a special prize, for which there were 26 entries, was carried out before the show, the number of entries and the keenness of the competition having quite warranted Mr. Chirnside's offering his valuable prize. There were also two exhibits for a model piggery. In addition to the foregoing, there were 267 stands-a record number-of machinery implements and miscellaneous non-competitive exhibits occupying the new ground, which for the first time had been made fully available-the whole display being highly creditable to the enterprise of exhibitors, who made it up without any incentive in the way of prize money. A massed parade of stock in the arena proved an attractive innovation, and, taken altogether, the show was a very fine one, and as it was favoured

with fine weather, it established a record, the profit being $\pounds 5557$ 15s. 4d., and the attendance reaching 150,000.

The Flock Book.

Last year it was reported that the Central Committee of the Flock Book for British breeds of sheep in Australia had published volume IV. It may be added that the Book contains 154 registered flocks, as compared with 99 in volume I. In the three years' interval from the publication of volume III., 14 flocks dropped out of the register, and 92 new ones were added, 71 of which were Lincolns, almost all being transfers from already registered flocks. The usual annual return forms have been sent out to registered flock owners, and a number of further applications have been received for registration, and these will be duly dealt with by the Central Committee. The amount at credit of the Flock Book Trust Account at the end of the year was $\pounds 144$ 6s. 3d.

Draught Horse Stud Book.

Volume IV. of the Draught Horse Stud Book of Australia has been published. It contains the three previous volumes, with the pedigrees revised and extended by Mr. Ewen T. Campbell, who has in his firm's books records of the pedigrees of most of the draught horses of the States. The pedigrees of 32 additional stallions, which, although dead, had left their mark on the draught horse stock of the State, were added to the book. Arising out of the Convention of the Chamber of Agriculture at Ballarat in July, when the question of publishing a stud book keeping Clydesdale and Shire horses separate, was raised, your Council called a Conference of Agricultural Society representatives during Show week to endeavour to ascertain the opinion and desire of breeders throughout the State in relation to the Stud Book. The majority of the representatives at the Conference, which was well attended, was against dividing the breeds. and a resolution was carried that the stud book be continued as heretofore, with the addition that foundation mares be allowed to come in on conformation alone. This latter clause, however, was afterwards objected to by the Draught Horse Stud Book Committee, who struck it out for the reason that it would lower the standard of the book. The Committee, with a view to dividing the breeds of Clydesdales and Shires at a later date if found advisable, has resolved that the entries for the fifth and subsequent volumes shall state to which of the two breeds or strains the animal entered belongs, and that a record of same be kept; and this has been adopted by your Council. Subsequently a

meeting of delegates was called by the Donald Agricultural Society at Ballarat in November in relation to the Stud Book. when a resolution was carried, that in the opinion of the Conference the differentiation between Shires and Clydesdales be determined by the Stud Book Committee, according to the preponderance of either blood in the animal proposed, and that where in the opinion of the Committee there may be difficulty in deciding where the preponderance lies it be left to the option of the applicant on which side the animal be entered. Mr. H. Alan Currie, who represented the Society at the Ballarat Conference. recommended that if the foregoing were adopted by your Council it would be necessary to insert a rule in the stud book as follows-"That no animal which is a cross between two animals entered and classed on the Clydesdale and Shire side of the stud book respectively, be eligible for entry in the stud book." As these resolutions followed on the lines already being worked on by the Draught Horse Committee, and were consequently quite practicable without interference with procedure already taken, they were adopted by your Council. Entries for volume V. were originally fixed, to close on 30th September, when 195 were received. In view, however, of the resolutions above referred to, and as there was no immediate necessity for closing the entries, the date for their reception was extended to 31st December, resulting in 320 additional entries, making the total for the volume 515. The amount standing to the credit of the Draught Horse Stud Book Trust Fund at the end of the year was £86 8s., exclusive of £56 for the additional entries, the total credit being £142 8s.

The Chamber of Agriculture

The eleventh annual meeting and eighth Annual Convention of the Chamber of Agriculture was held at Ballarat on the 5th, 6th and 7th July. The Convention was officially opened by His Excellency the Governor, Sir Thomas Gibson Carmichael, and was attended by a very large and representative gathering of delegates. The Society's representatives were Messrs. A. McNaughton (representative on the Council of the Chamber), H. Alan Currie, C. W. Campbell and A. E. T. Payne, all of whom reported on the Convention, which they highly eulogised. Your Council passed a resolution congratulating the Chamber on the great success of the Convention, and heartily thanking the Ballarat Agricultural Society for its hospitality and courtesy to delegates. The Annual Convention of the Chamber has now grown to such dimensions that there are not many towns in the State which can accommodate the large assemblage of delegates.

The Council.

At the first meeting of the Council in February, Mr. Alexander McCracken was re-elected president, and Messrs. T. F. Rutledge, C. W. Campbell, and H. Alan Currie were elected vice-presidents. In February, Mr. R. H. Dugdale, who was elected to the Council at the annual meeting in February, 1909, lost his seat through non-attendance. In the following month Mr. J. C. Rockliff was nominated against Mr. Dugdale, and was elected in his place. In April the death of the Hon. Thomas Skene was reported to the Council. At the same meeting, Mr. T. F. Cumming resigned his seat on account of the close attention he had to give to the business of the Licenses Reduction Board, of which he was a member. Mr. Cumming was elected to the Council in 1894, and was president in 1904 and 1905. Mr. F. W. Fairbairn was elected in the room of Mr. Skene, and Mr. William Kendell in place of Mr. Cumming. In September the death of Mr. James Wilson was reported. Mr. Wilson was elected to the Council in 1902, and took a lively interest in the work of the Society. Mr. George L. Wilson, Mr. Wilson's son, was elected in his place. In December Messrs. George Fairbairn (M.H.R.), F. W. Fairbairn and Donald Stewart lost their seats through non-attendance. In this month, also, Mr. George Chirnside was welcomed back to the Council on his return from England, where he had represented the Society at the International Sheepbreeders' Conference at Gloucester.

Death of Mr. Skene.

Through the death of the Hon. Thomas Skene in April, the Council lost one of its most highly-valued members. Elected to the Council in 1892, Mr. Skene at once took a leading part in the affairs of the Society. In November, 1896, he proposed that the work of compiling and publishing a Flock Book for pure sheep should be undertaken by the Society, and the immediate result was the establishment of the Flock Book for British Breeds of Sheep in Victoria, afterwards extended to Australia. The work has reached its fourth volume, published in 1909, and has been a pronounced success financially and otherwise, and Mr. Skene devoted a great deal of time to the business of dealing with the flocks admitted to volume I., which furnished the basis of the subsequent volumes. At the annual meeting in 1899, Mr. Skene threw out a suggestion for the establishment of a Chamber of Agriculture, and the matter was taken up by Mr. F. Peppin, resulting in the formation of the present Chamber, which has grown into a most important and influential body, of which particulars are given in a previous portion of this report. In 1805

Mr. Skene took a very active part in promoting the quarterly social dinners of the Society, at which valuable papers were read and discussed, and which, after being continued for two years, were abandoned on account of lack of interest and poor attendances. In 1898, in connection with the Greater Britain and Paris Exhibition, Mr. Skene, with the Secretary, visited a number of shows for exhibits, with such results that the Council received a letter of thanks for their action in the connection. Mr. Skene was president of the Society in 1897 and 1898, and again in 1906-7-8, his services having been particularly valuable to the Society, while his genial qualities and goodness of heart endeared him to all the members, his untimely death being widely and deeply deplored not only by the Society, but also by the whole community.

Resignation of Secretary.

In December the Secretary, Mr. Thomas Patterson, who was appointed to the position by the Council in August, 1880, tendered his resignation in the following letter, which explainsitself:—

Melbourne, 13th December, 1910.

The President, Vice-Presidents and Members of the Council of the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria.

Gentlemen,-

On account of overstrain, my health, before the Show, was so unsatisfactory, that it was against medical advice 1 carried on; and, although now much improved, I am still strongly recommended to give up work entirely for some time to come, and go away for a prolonged holiday. Believing that I have earned a rest, and that one's health is a primary consideration, I have decided—not without a considerable wrench—to accept advice, and leave for Europe at as early a date as practicable on a tour of six or eight months' duration. I therefore beg most respectfully to tender the resignation of my position as Secretary to your Society.

In resigning my appointment after over 30 years' service, as the Chief Executive Officer of the Institution. I desire to be permitted to express my grateful thanks to the many Presidents, Vice-Presidents, and members of Council, under whom I have worked; for their great kindness and consideration extended to me, all along the line of my long term of office.

Through my father having been one of the founders of the Society, and through his having also, so far back as 1856, established the Mornington Branch of the old Port Phillip Farmers' Society, of which he was for some years Honorary Secretary and Treasurer, and afterwards President---thus causing me to be reared in an atmosphere of Shows. I have, over and above my official duty, taken, and always will take, a keen personal interest in the work of this Society; and, furthermore, have been as jealous of its reputation as I have of my own, throughout my whole career.

There is abundant evidence in my writings-from the published letter. I addressed to subscribers and the public on my appointment; throughout my leading articles and comments during the years I was Editor of the Society's Journal, and elsewhere in the many reports I have written—of my faith in the possibilities of this Institution, so that the crowning achievement of our recent record Show was quite within even my earliest anticipations.

In conclusion, I most sincerely wish the Society continued and increasing prosperity in all its operations.

The President (Mr. McCracken) himself read the letter to the Council, which then went into Committee.

On resuming, the President said the announcement of the retirement was received with much disappointment. The President and Members of Council having eulogised the long, loyal and worthy services of Mr. Patterson as Secretary, the Council unanimously resolved to accept the resignation with deep regret, and, in appreciation of efficient services and as a token of personal esteem, to ask Mr. Patterson's acceptance of a retiring honorarium of \pounds_{300} and the life membership of the Society.

The Council, on behalf of the members and itself, desires to place on the official records of the Society grateful acknowledgment of Mr. Patterson's thirty years of faithful, assiduous and competent offices, specially marked by devotion to the Society's interests, high principle and literary merit; and to thankfully recognise the great progress made by the Society under Mr. Patterson's wise guidance and care.

Mr. Patterson, in feeling terms, acknowledged the compliments paid to him.

The Journa.

In February the Council adopted a report of the Editing Committee, to the effect that they had considered the matter of the agreement with the publishers of the journal, and recommended the continuance of the agreement with the proprietors of the "Farmer and Grazier" to 31st December following, and, further, that at the November meeting applications be invited for the conduct of the official journal of the Society. Tenders were accordingly called, and from six applications, that of the proprietors of the "Australian Farm and Home" was chosen, the terms being 1s. 3d. per member per annum, and $\pounds 1$ is. per meeting for reporting, and recommended by the Editing Committee to the Council, who adopted the recommendation. Members will therefore during the next twelve months receive "The Australian Farm and Home" (incorporating the Journal of the Society) in the place of the "Farmer and Grazier," which had been the organ of the Society for 17 years. In adopting the report of the Editing Committee, the Council expressed appreciation of the "Farmer and Grazier" during the years it had been the official organ of the Society.

Death of the King.

In May the death occurred of His Majesty King Edward VII. Your Council met and adjourned immediately, after resolving to forward the following cable to the Royal Family through the proper officials. "The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria expresses profound sorrow at the death of His Late Majesty, and respectfully offers their Majesties the King and Queen, the Dowager Queen, and the Royal Family, sincere sympathy."—(Signed) Alexander McCracken, President. Later on at the July meeting, your Council resolved to

Later on at the July meeting, your Council resolved to subscribe £25 towards the King Edward Memorial Fund.

Queensland List of Judges.

In January the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies wrote, asking the Council to nominate judges in the several sections of a form they forwarded, with the object of compiling a printed list. The matter was referred to the Secretary, who drew up a list of judges, which was submitted to the Council, and with two or three additions, adopted and forwarded to Queensland. The book list of judges has been received, and is available in the office for reference by members.

Fares to Show Grounds.

In July a deputation from your Council waited on the Railway Commissioners to request that the return fares to the Show be reduced to 6d. and 4d. Ist and 2nd class respectively. The claims of the Society to a concession were strongly impressed on the Commissioners, who granted a reduction on the 1st class return fare from 1/- to 9d., the other fares to remain as before viz., 1st single, 6d.; 2nd return, 6d.; 2nd single, 3d.

Proposed Commonwealth Exhibition.

At the September meeting your Council considered the matter of a National Exhibition, which had been raised in the press during Show week, and resolved to call a Conference of representatives from the leading Agricultural Society in each State on 2nd November (Melbourne Cup week), with the object of discussing the proposal—the object being as set out in the circular, "to bring about by combined action of the Australian States a thoroughly representative National Exhibition to illustrate to the world the magnificent natural and industrial resources of the Commonwealth and the splendid capabilities of its soil and climate in producing stock of all breeds, and agricultural produce of infinite variety of as high a standard as can be reached in any other part of the globe."

The Conference was held, and all the States of the Commonwealth were represented—there being present from New South Wales: Hon. Sir Francis Suttor, S. E. Lees, Henry Dawson, H. M. Somer (Secretary); West Australia: Rt. Hon. Sir John Forrest, Hon. Sydney Stubbs, Isidore Emanuel; Queensland: Ernest Baynes, John Reid, C. H. Arvier (Secretary); Tasmania: Hon. C. E. Davies; South Australia: H. Denton, J. W. Sandford; Victoria: A. McCracken, H. Alan Currie, C. E. Merrett, T. Patterson (Secretary).

Mr. A. McCracken was elected Chairman and Mr. T. Patterson Secretary.

The Chairman welcomed the delegates, and the question of the proposal to hold a Great National Exhibition to illustrate to the world the magnificent natural and industrial resources of the Commonwealth was discussed at length.

It was then resolved that copies of the debate (which was taken down in shorthand) be sent to each Society represented, for the consideration of their Councils; and that they report to a Committee to be appointed by the Convention, the Committee to consist of the President of each Society represented, or his deputy—the questions remitted being the proposals to hold:—

1. An International Exhibition.

2. A Commonwealth Agricultural and Pastoral Exhibition
or Show—the idea to be amplified by the addition of industrial
exhibits pertaining to the soil and to agricultural and pastoral interests.

3. No exhibition.

Your Council dealt with the matter at the December meeting, and resolved that it might be well to hold a Commonwealth Agricultural and Pastoral Exhibition a year or two hence, but for the present the subject could stand over. The resolutions of the Societies of the other States represented have not yet come to hand.

Protographic Group.

At the conclusion of the Conference a group photograph of the delegates was taken. As the group contains representatives of the leading Agricultural and Pastoral Society in each State of the Commonwealth, and as it is the first time such a Federal Agricultural Conference has been held, the picture will have historic value. Your Council is retaining a copy for the office, and is forwarding one to each of the other Societies represented in the group. The photograph gives the names of the delegates, as well as the States they represent.

Enlarged Photo of Show Grounds.

In September your Council received an enlarged framed photograph of the Brisbane (Queensland) Society's Show Grounds, and it was resolved to have an enlarged photograph of the Melbourne Royal Show Grounds framed and sent to the other leading State Societies in the Commonwealth, your Council keeping one for their own office. The photograph chosen represents the Society's first massed parade, and makes a very attractive picture.

Members' Subscriptions.

In March your Council adopted a general circular to the public, which called attention to the work and objects of the Society, and invited subscriptions—7000 copies being printed and circulated. Only 35 subscriptions were directly credited to this circular, but the roll has been increased during the year by 137 members. By way of review, it may be stated that the year the Society was established (1871) there were secured by a vigorous canvass 370 subscribers, in 1880 the year the present (retiring) Secretary took office there were 369 members, or one short of the number in the year the Society was established nine years previously. In 1899 the Society secured over 1000 subscribers, which was then a record for any Agricultural Society in Australasia. The numbers have steadily increased, till this year the Society's roll exceeds 2000, standing at 2004 subscribers.

Donations.

The donations to the prize fund this year amount to $\pounds 472$ 17s. Since the present (retiring) Secretary took office in 1880, which, with the past year 1910 inclusive, makes 31 years, the prize money subscribed by private donor; amounts to $\pounds 17,435$ 7s. 3d., the smallest sum being $\pounds 186$ 15s. in 1880, the largest $\pounds 909$ 18s. in 1889—the average per annum throughout being $\pounds 562$ 8s. 7d.

Wines at Cellars.

In October it was resolved, on the report of the Secretary in relation to the Wine Department, that the wines which had accumulated for two years at the Exhibition cellars should be sold. When sorted up they were found to amount to $90\frac{1}{2}$ dozen, which sold for £62 os. 6d., thus averaging 13s. 8d. per dozen. In 1908 five years' collection, consisting of $216\frac{1}{2}$ dozen, was sold for £109 4s. 3d., averaging 10s. 1d. per dozen, so that this year's price was considerably better than that obtained at the last sale.

Acknowledgments.

Your Council desire to thank His Excellency the Governor,. Sir Thomas Gibson-Carmichael, for having officially opened the Show, and to express their appreciation of the practical interest His Excellency manifested in every Department of the Exhibition, which he very thoroughly inspected. They again thank the Minister of Agriculture for providing champion medals for competition. They express their great indebtedness to donors tothe prize fund for their liberality, to which special reference is made under a previous heading. They acknowledge their indebtedness to the judges who acted at this Show for the first time under the single judge system; when also for the first time their rail and boat fares were allowed to those who applied for They also thank the Stewards for assisting in carrying same. out the work of the Show. They specially thank the leading Agricultural Societies of the sister States of the Commonwealth for their courtesy in complying with the invitation to be represented at the first Federal Agricultural Conference in Melbourne Cup week, to which allusion is made elsewhere. They are again greatly indebted to the press for invaluable aid, and to all who have forwarded the interests of the Society during the year they return their best thanks.

Finance.

In the audited statement of accounts published herewith the revenue is shown to be $\pounds 12,141$ 2s. 8d., an advance of $\pounds 1939$ 15s. 5d. on the previous year. The expenditure, including $\pounds 2905$ 10s. in cash prizes and medals, $\pounds 4110$ 14s. 9d. in buildings and maintenance, and $\pounds 435$ in land purchase, amounted to $\pounds 12,204$ 19s. 10d., the overdraft being increased from $\pounds 8084$ 13s. 3d. to $\pounds 8148$ 10s. 5d. Taking the expenditures in permanent improvements and on land as assets, the working expenses show a profit on the year's transactions of $\pounds 4481$ 17s. 7d., which constitutes: a record result.



RULES.

The Society shall be called The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria.

2. The objects of the Society shall be to promote the development of the Agricultural, Pastoral and Industrial Resources of the State—

- (1.) By holding Exhibitions at such places and times as the Council shall appoint; and by offering and awarding prizes and premiums at all such Exhibitions, if deemed desirable.
- (2.) By holding meetings at such places and times as the Council shall appoint, at which meetings papers may be read and discussed.
- (3.) By collecting such information from Agricultural publications, scientific, and other works, as may be useful in promoting the objects of the Society.
- (4.) By corresponding with Agricultural and other kindred societies at home and abroad, and collecting from such correspondence all information which, in the opinion of the Council, may lead to practical benefit in the cultivation of the soil and breeding of stock, as well as in the prosecution of other important industries.
- (5.) By encouraging the attention of men of science to the discovery of better methods of cultivation, to the improvement of agricultural implements and machinery, the construction of farm buildings, the application of chemistry to the general purposes of agriculture, the destruction of insects injurious to vegetable life, and the eradication or utilisation of weeds.
- (6.) By promoting the discovery and introduction of new varieties of cereals, vegetables, or grasses suitable to the climate, and capable of being cultivated with profit; and also the introduction of desirable kinds and varieties of live stock.
- (7.) By collecting information regarding the management of plantations, live-fences, and other subjects connected with rural improvement.
- (8.) By investigating the nature of diseases in animals or plants, and taking measures for the publication, at such times and periods as the Council may appoint, of the information thus collected, together with all approved original essays sent in. lectures delivered, or papers read to the Society; besides making provision for the establishment and maintenancé of a Library and Reading Room for the use of Members.

(9.) By remunerating any person, if thought fit, who shall ascertain by experiment how far such information may lead to useful results in practice, for any loss incurred by such experiments.

3. The Society shall consist of a President, three Vice-Presidents, three Trustees, Governors, Members, Honorary Members, Honorary Scientific Members (not exceeding six in number), and Corresponding Members.

4. Every candidate for admission into the Society, by giving his name and address, with his subscription, to the Secretary, shall be duly constituted a Member of the same, and shall have all the rights of membership till the day after the Annual Meeting next ensuing. Providing that when any subscription shall be paid in the name of any firm or company, they shall at time of paying such subscription nominate one of the members of the firm or company, who shall be entitled to and exercise the rights and privileges attached to such membership, and may be elected to any office.

5. Governors shall pay a subscription of three pounds, and Members one pound, annually, in advance, with power to compound for life by the payment in one sum of ten annual subscriptions.

6. The Society shall be managed by a Council consisting of thirty-three Members, elected from amongst the Governors and Members of the Society as hereinafter provided, and also the Trustees, who shall be ex officio Members of the Council.

7. One-third of the Council, except the Trustees, shall retire annually in rotation, but shall be eligible for re-election.

8. Land acquired, or to be acquired, for the Society shall be held by and be vested in the Trustees for the time being of the Society for and on behalf of the Society. The Trustees shall hold office until disqualified, or until they are removed in due course at the Annual or at a Special General Meeting of the Society. Any new Trustee or Trustees shall be appointed at the Annual or at a Special General Meeting of the Society, or in accordance with Rule 14. The Trustees shall deal with the lands of the Society as directed by resolution of the Council of the Society (of which an entry in the Minute Book shall be conclusive evidence), and they shall be indemnified against risk and expense out of the Society's property.

9. The Council shall, at their first meeting after the annual election in each year, elect out of their own number (which includes the Trustees), a President, and three Vice-Presidents.

10. The Council shall have the entire management of the income and funds of the Society, and all other affairs thereof.

11. The Council shall have power to appoint and remove all paid officers of the Society.

12. The Council shall have power to elect Honorary, Honorary Scientific, and Corresponding Members; nominations having been submitted at a previous meeting, and a circular having been sent to each Member of the Council. The Honorary Scientific Members shall retire annually, and shall be eligible for re-election. 13. Governors and Honorary Scientific Members may attend meetings of the Council, and take part in discussions thereat, but shall not have power to vote.

14. The Council may fill up any vacancies in its own body created by death, resignation, or occurring in any other way amongst its office-bearers.

15. The Council shall have power to make or amend such regulations as they think necessary.

16. The Council shall be regulated in its proceedings by such By-laws as shall from time to time be enacted by it, conformably with the Constitution and objects of the Society; but no By-law shall in any case be altered, or new one proposed, unless notice of such intention has been given at a previous meeting, and sent to each member of the Council.

17. The Society's financial year shall end on the 31st of December; and a Preliminary General Meeting shall be held on the second Tuesday in January following, to arrange the business and receive notices of motion for the Annual General Meeting, to appoint a paid and an honorary Auditor, and to nominate gentlemen to fill the places of retiring office-bearers. Previous to the meeting, the Council shall have prepared a list of Governors and Members nominated by them to fill the vacancies, to which list of candidates the names of any other Governors and Members may be added on their being duly proposed and seconded at the meeting.

18. The Annual General Meeting shall be held on the first Thursday in February, at which meeting the Annual Report and Balance Sheet shall be submitted, office-bearers elected, and any other business transacted of which due notice may have been given.

19. Fourteen days at least before the Annual General Meeting the President or his Deputy shall send to all subscribers to the Society (Governors or Members) a ballot paper, numbered and initialled by the President or his Deputy, or the Secretary, with the names of all the candidates who have been duly nominated, and each subscriber desiring to vote shall erase therefrom all names he thinks fit. Provided that any ballot paper containing more or less than the required number of names shall be rejected by the President (who shall be Returning Officer) or his Deputy at the election. Every such ballot paper shall be returned sealed, on or before the closing of the poll, which shall be at three o'clock p.m. on the day of the election, and the said ballot papers shall be opened and counted when the Returning Officer is making up the poll.

20. Seven days at least before the Annual Meeting a copy of the Report and audited Balance Sheet for the preceding financial year shall be forwarded to every subscriber to the Society (Governors or Members).

21. The Secretary shall report to the meeting of the Council next after the Annual Meeting the gentlemen elected to fill the vacancies in the Council.

22. A Special General Meeting of the Society may be called at any time by the Secretary, on direction of the President, or on the requisition of ten Members of the Society, but no business shall be transacted at any such meeting other than that for which it has been called.

23. A Special Meeting of the Council may be summoned by direction of the President, or of three members of the Council, but no business then transacted shall be valid unless confirmed by special resolution at the subsequent Ordinary Meeting.

24. The privileges of Membership shall consist of power to vote at the election of office-bearers, of free admission to the library, Reading Room, and Lectures, and, with two ladies, to. the Society's Exhibitions, grounds, and grand stands at all times on production of the Member's ticket for the current year. And while the Society publishes a monthly journal, a copy shall be posted free to each Member.

25. Any Member guilty of conduct, calculated to bring the Society into discredit in connection with its General Meetings, its Meetings of Council, its Exhibitions, or other objects, shall be liable to be brought before the Council, and, if found guilty, shall be subject to reprimand, or to have his name expunged from the Roll of Members, and may be disqualified from exhibiting during the plassure of the Council during the pleasure of the Council.

26. Any person being disqualified by any kindred society shall not be allowed to become a Member or to exhibit at this Society's Exhibitions until such disqualification be removed, pro-vided such disqualification be confirmed by the Council of this Society.

27. Any dispute as to the interpretation of the rules, bylaws, regulations, or provisions shall be determined by the Council, whose decision shall be final.

28. These Rules shall not be altered except by a majority of the Members present at the Annual or at a Special General Meeting of not less than ten Members, exclusive of Members of Council.

BY-LAWS.

GENERAL MEETINGS.

1. Notice of the Preliminary, Annual, and Special General Meetings of the Society shall be given in such newspapers as the Council may decide, and by circular through post to every Governor and Member; and all matters, except the election of the office-bearers at the Annual Meeting, shall be determined by a show of hands, unless a division is called for. At every Annual General Meeting the minutes of the last Annual Meeting, and the minutes of the preceding Preliminary General Meeting, shall be read and confirmed; a report, together with a financial statement from the Council, shall be submitted, and any Governor or Member present may propose any question to the Council respecting the matters contained in such report, and comment thereon, or may refer to such other matters relating to the government of the Society and the management of its affairs as to him may seem proper, provided that his remarks have reference to some motion of which notice has been previously given at the Preliminary General Meeting.

 2. The President or his Deputy shall conduct the election at the Annual General Meeting, at which meeting two or more scrutineers shall be chosen by the President or his Deputy to assist in making up the state of the poll.
 3. Should it be deemed advisable to remove one or more of

3. Should it be deemed advisable to remove one or more of the Trustees from office, notice to that effect must be given at the Preliminary General Meeting, or one month previous to any Special General Meeting, nominations to be made at the former meeting and elections to take place at the latter. Extraordinary vacancies amongst the Trustees may be filled up by the Council, or at the Annual General Meeting.

THE PRESIDENT.

4. The President shall, in all official relations of the Society, take precedence of all other Governors and Members, and shall take the chair when present, having (as well as any other Chairman of the Council) the privilege of a casting vote in addition to his own in all cases of equality in a division on any question. He shall sign all such letters, votes of thanks, and other documents as the Council may direct to be written in the name or on behalf of the Council.

THE COUNCIL.

5. The Council shall hold a meeting at least every month, on such a day and at such an hour as the Council may decide, for the transaction of the business of the Society, and may adjourn from time to time at its discretion.

6. At the monthly meetings the Council shall have full power to originate, discuss, and decide by a majority of votes on a show of hands, all questions not involving an unusual outlay of money brought before it; provided that if any three members present regard any proposition brought forward as too important for immediate decision, they may object and demand the usual month's notice, whereupon all discussion on the question shall cease.

7. No motion, the effect of which, if carried, would be to rescind any motion previously passed by the Council during the same year, shall be entertained unless one month's notice be given to the Council.

8. The ruling of the Chairman shall be final in all matters of order and practice.

9. If within half an hour after the time at which any meeting of the Council is called a quorum of Members be not present, the Members present, or the majority of them, or any one Member, if one only be present, or the Secretary, if no Member be present, may adjourn such meeting to any time not longer than fourteen days from the date of such adjournment, providing that no meeting shall be held on a public holiday, and should an Ordinary Meeting fall on a holiday the Secretary shall be empowered to postpone the date of such meeting, and call it not later than ten days after the date on which it otherwise would have been held.

10. Minutes of the proceedings of every meeting of the Council or of any Committee shall be taken during their progress by the Secretary, or, in case of his absence, by some Member present whom the Chairman may appoint for the occasion. The minutes shall afterwards be fairly copied into a minute book kept for that purpose.

11. The Council shall, from time to time, draw up such By-laws as may appear to them expedient for conducting the proceedings of their own meetings, which shall be binding on the members of the Council, and all such By-laws shall be binding on all and every, the Governors and Members, Honorary, Honor-ary Scientifie, and Corresponding Members, officers, and servants of the Society, as well as on all exhibitors or their assistants at the Society's Exhibition.

12. The Council may appoint Committees to examine into or take action on any special matter relating to the objects or business of the Society, and may dissolve such Committees whensoever they shall think proper.

13. The Council shall appoint a banker or bankers to the Society, to whom all sums of money received by the Secretary

Society, to whom all sums of money received by the Secretary or other persons for the use of the Society shall be paid. 14. No money shall be drawn from the Society's banking account but by order of the Council, after a report from the Finance Committee, and by cheques signed by two members of such Committee, and countersigned by the Secretary. Entries shall be made of all such payments. 15. If any office-bearer, with the exception of the Trust-shall be absent from three consecutive monthly meetings of the Council without leave having heap obtained his yeat shall be

Council without leave having been obtained, his seat shall be declared vacant.

16. The Secretary shall notify to the Council, on the Agenda Paper, any vacancy which may have occurred in the list of President, Vice-Presidents, Trustees, or other members of the Council, at the meeting of the Council next after the happening of such vacancy; and such vacancy shall not be filled up until the monthly meeting of the Council which shall take place next after such notice.

17. In the absence of the President, the chair shall be taken by a Vice-President; and should none of these officers be present. then by such Member as the Council shall choose as their Chairman by a majority of votes.

18. The quorum of a Monthly or Special Council shall be five.

19. At every monthly meeting of Council the order of business shall be as follows :---

(1.) Reading and confirming minutes of previous meeting.

(2.) Business arising from minutes.

- (3.) Election of officers, and nominations for vacancies.
- (4.) Finance Committee's Report.
- (5.) Motions.

(7.) Postponed business.

(8.) Notices of motions.

20. All minutes and reports read at, and adopted by the Council shall be signed by the Chairman.

21. The report from the Council to the Annual Meeting in February shall be prepared at the Council meeting first in January or at some adjournment thereot.

COMMITTEES.

22. The Council shall elect such standing Committees at the monthly Council meeting in February as they think fit, which shall remain in office until the Annual General Meeting in the ensuing year, two members of Committee to form a quorum. 23. The President shall be ex officio a member of all com-

mittees.

24. Each Committee, at its first meeting, shall elect its own Chairman for the year, and in his absence a Chairman shall be elected by the Committee for the occasion.

25. All Committees shall make or adopt rules for the conduct of their business, and shall make a report of their proceedings to the Council, and shall hold office until they have made their respective reports; but in case such reports shall not have been made previous to the first Thursday in February next after their appointment, their powers shall then cease, providing that standing Committees shall retain office till their successors are appointed.

THE SECRETARY.

26. The Secretary shall be immediately responsible to the Council for the discharge of his various duties. He shall attend the sittings of all meetings of the Council, and of Committees, and shall keep all the Society's books. He shall also conduct the correspondence of the Society, and keep letter books, in which copies of all letters on the business of the Society shall be entered

27. Under the direction of the Finance Committee, he shall be responsible for all moneys received, paying such sums into the hands of the Society's bankers, and producing at each meeting of the Finance Committee receipts for the same; and, excepting the amounts allowed him for petty cash, he shall not retain in his hands any money belonging to the Society, but shall pay it over forthwith to the Society's bankers. He shall have the charge of the expenditure of petty cash.

28. He shall have the custody of all books, models and papers belonging to the Society. All books, pamphlets, etc., becoming the property of the Society shall be stamped with the Society's stamp at once.

29. He shall have the immediate superintendence over the clerks and servants of the Society, and shall be required to report to the Council any instances of misconduct on their part which he thinks of such a nature as to require the consideration of the Council.

30. He shall find, if required, approved security to the amount of £500, the premium to be paid by the Society.

31. The Secretary shall not exercise any of the privileges of a Governor or Member of the Society.

FINANCE.

32. The Finance Committee shall have the immediate care of the Society's funds, and shall meet on the Friday before the ordinary Council meeting in each month, in order to prepare a report for the Council on the state of the Society's funds, which they shall present to each monthly meeting in the following form :—

as well as a statement of the payments recommended to be made, together with all the books in which entries of cash receipts or payments are made, and such documents as the business of the day may require. Should a report from the Finance Committee not have been presented at the meeting of the Council, the Secretary shall report the state of the funds to the Council, in which case the Council shall vote the moneys required without such report.

33. The Chairman of the Finance Committee shall be the Honorary Treasurer of the Society.

34. All receipts for money received on behalf of the Society shall be out of a book with counterpart.

35. All moneys received and paid shall be entered daily in a general cash book.

36. Once in every year—not later than two weeks after the Preliminary General Meeting—there shall be an audit of the Society's accounts by a professional accountant, assisted by an honorary auditor, before whom a balance sheet shall be laid by the Secretary, which audited account shall be presented at the Annual Meeting.
