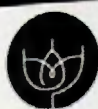

Mix well together and reserve half cup combined nuts and glace fruits for garnishing. Beat eggs until light and fluffy. Add sugar, vanilla essence, rum and softened butter. Continue beating until well blended. Sift flour with baking powder and salt. Add to the creamed mixture with fruit and nuts. Mix thoroughly. Lightly grease a loaf pan approximately 25cm x 12cm and line the base. Spoon mixture evenly into pan. Arrange reserved fruit and nuts over the top, pressing down gently. Bake in a slow oven for about 1½ hours, or until cake is firm to touch. Allow to cool slightly in the tin before turning out.

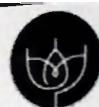
