GOATS

REGULATIONS OF GOAT COMPETITION

301. The Regulations appearing in this Schedule form part of the General Regulations and conditions of entry to an Event at the Royal Melbourne Show. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these Regulations, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES

302. Entries in the Goat competition must be received by the RASV Administration Offices, Melbourne Showgrounds, Epsom Road, Ascot Vale, Victoria 3032 by no later than 5:00pm on Friday 23 July 2010. All entries must be accompanied by the applicable fee and health status declaration form.

303. The onus is entirely on the Exhibitor to submit particulars on time. There will be no reminder from RASV staff.

304. In accordance with General Regulation 8.2, to create competition the RASV reserves the right to amend, consolidate or cancel classes offered in this competition schedule

SUBSTITUTIONS

305. Exhibitors have the option to nominate substitute entries, of which all details must be completed in the space provided on the Entry Form. If an exhibitor wishes to exhibit a substitute animal in lieu of the original nomination, advice in writing must be in the hands of the RASV no later than 5:00pm Friday 20 August 2010.

ENTRY FEES

306. Entry Fees for Goat breeds are as follows (straw inclusive):

Per animal \$30 per entry (GST free) for Members

\$48 per entry (GST free) for Non-members

Kids & Goatlings \$15 per entry (GST free) for Members

\$23 per entry (GST free) for Non-members

Goat Carcase \$30 per pen (max. three per pen) (GST free) for Members

\$48 per pen (max. three per pen) (GST free) for

Non-members

307. This entry fee entitles the Exhibitor to enter the animal in all eligible classes. Please specify selected classes on enclosed Entry Form.

SCAN FEES

308. All Goat Carcase animals must be scanned.

309. Scan fees have been set at \$6.50 per animal. This amount must be shown separately on your Entry Form and the amount included with your total entry payment.

CATALOGUES

310. Each exhibitor is to pre purchase one catalogue for \$10.00 with their initial entry. Upon arrival at the Showgrounds you will be given your catalogue, which will be included in your exhibitor pack. Additional catalogues can be purchased from the Superintendent's Office.

TEUCK PARKING

311. Parking for trucks and floats will be available. Apply by completing the relevant section on the Entry Form and forward the fee with the competition entry fee.

312. Truck parking fees for 2010 will be:

313. Please indicate on the Entry Form the dimensions and make/model of your truck/trailer.

314. There is to be no camping in the truck park under any circumstances.

315. Any vehicle, including trucks, stock transports, trailers, and horse floats, located on the Showgrounds, or any area leased by the RASV, shall be at the sole risk of the owner. The RASV accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage, including loss or damage caused by negligence of the RASV, its officers, employees, or agents to any vehicle, or the contents of any vehicle, located on the RASV's property or in the area leased by the RASV.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS

316. All Goat Exhibitors are to comply with the following arrival and departure timings, unless otherwise notified directly by the RASV Event Coordinator.

317. Arrival and Departure times are as follows:

Dairy Goats:

Arrival: Friday 17 September 2010 between 6:00pm and 9:00pm.

Departure: Tuesday 21 September 2010 between 5:00pm and 9:00pm.

Boer Goats:

Arrival: Sunday 19 September 2010 between 6:00pm and 8:00pm Departure: Tuesday 21 September 2010 between 6:00pm and

9:00pm

318. Priority may be given to Exhibitors that have considerable distance to travel.

PERIOD OF EXHIBITION

Dairy Goats:

319. All Dairy goats are required to be in their correct pens by 9:00pm on Friday 17 September 2010 and prior to strip outs.

Boer Goats

320. All Boer goats are required to be in their correct pens by 8.00pm on Sunday 19 September 2010.

ACCOMMODATION LOCKERS

321. Accommodation Locker prices are \$100.00 (GST inc.) of which \$20.00 is a key deposit. On return of Locker Key a refund will be issued. Due to limited Accommodation Lockers, we reserve the right to limit allocation in an effort to accommodate all Exhibitors.

BEDDING

322. No bedding other than straw may be used in pens.

323. For the convenience of Exhibitors, fodder merchants will attend the Showgrounds for the purpose of accepting orders for stock foods, etc and the delivery of food stocks must be made before 8:00am each day during the Show.

STOCK ATTENDANT PASSES

324. A Confirmation of Entries will be issued prior to the Show.

325. The Confirmation of Entries document must be produced at the gate, when it will admit the Exhibitor and Exhibits on to the Showgrounds. It must be retained, and again produced when the Exhibit leaves the Showgrounds. Stock Attendant Passes will be issued by the Superintendent at his office on the Showgrounds once Exhibits have been penned.

326. Stock Attendant Passes will be issued according to the following formula:

One Stock Attendant Pass for every Exhibitor.

Additionally: One Stock Attendant Pass for three to five Exhibits

Two Stock Attendant Passes for six to ten Exhibits

Three Stock Attendant Passes for eleven or more

Exhibits.

CLEANLINESS OF PENS

327. Mucking out of pens is to be carried out between 8:00pm and 7:00am. These times will be strictly enforced.

328. Exhibitors must keep the pens allotted to their animals clean and give proper attention to their stock throughout the Show. Cleaning of pens occupied by Exhibits must be completed before 7:00am each day.

ADVERTISING

329. Exhibitors are permitted to display cards over the pens allotted to them stating that an animal is for private sale. These cards are not to exceed 30cm x 25cm. No other advertisement or notices (except by permission of the RASV) are permitted on or in any stalls or buildings.

330. Each Exhibitor is permitted to display one sign 60cm x 120cm in size provided that such sign carries only the stud name, address, telephone number, facsimile number, e-mail address and website address.

SMOKING

331. Smoking and naked flames are at all times prohibited in Lockers and Pavilions.

REGISTRATION

- 332. All goats entered in this Section must be registered in a herd book recognised by the RASV or recorded in the appendix sections of a herd book recognised by the RASV.
- 333. All Boer Goats must be registered with the Boer Goat Breeder's Association of Australia (BGBAA) and must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor at date of entry.
- 334. For particulars of registration of Dairy Goats in the Goat Herd Book of Australia, apply to The Secretary, P.O. Box 9048 Traralgon 3844.
- 335. For particulars of registration in the Boer Goat Breeders' Association of Australia Ltd, apply to The Secretary, Victorian Branch, Judith D'Aloisio (03) 5797 3232.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

- 336. All Goat entries must be accompanied by a signed National Goat Health Statement and goats must have a minimum assurance rating of two.
- 337. The 2010 Goat Competitions will be conducted under the guidelines as set out in the Johne's Disease Market Assurance Program (GoatMAP).

CAPRINE ARTHRITIS ENCEPHALITIS (CAE)

- 338. Dairy Goats will not be permitted to enter the Showgrounds unless Exhibitors provide a Veterinary Certificate to the effect that the goats to be exhibited:
- a) are from a CAE accredited free herd or;
- b) have had a least one negative ELISA test after 1 January 2010, and show no clinical signs of the virus or;
- c) have had at least one (1) negative test after 1 January 2010 for Johne's Disease and show no clinical signs (for goats over 12 months).
- These certificates must be submitted to the RASV office by Friday 23 July 2010 or the relevant entries will be cancelled.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SCHEME (NLIS)

339. All meat and fibre producing goats are required to be NLIS tagged when attending the Show. Dairy Goat breeds are exempt from NLIS tagging requirements.

VENDOR DECLARATIONS

340. All Goats entered in the Carcase Competition must have a Vendor Declaration signed and handed to the carrier before departure to the Abattoir.

UNSAFE EXHIBITS

341. If, in its absolute discretion the RASV determines any Exhibit or Exhibits to be dangerous, for any reason whatsoever, the RASV may by notice to the Exhibitor require the animal, or animals concerned, to be forthwith removed from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animals and failing such removal by him within the time prescribed by the RASV, the RASV may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the RASV.

IN MILK AND DRY CLASSES

- 342. A fee will be charged for each Doe competing in the milk test for the testing of the samples.
- 343. A Doe entered as "in milk" can be transferred to a "dry" or unkidded class, whichever is applicable, if she has not kidded prior to judging day, and vice versa.

- 344. Does in milk must be at the Showgrounds on Friday 17 September 2010 to be fully milked out and stripped dry at 8:00pm on Saturday 18 September 2010, in the presence of the Stewards or whomever they may appoint. The owner or his/her representative must be in attendance when females are being stripped dry.
- 345. Does must be fully milked out and stripped dry at 8:00pm Monday 20 September 2010 in the presence of the Stewards or whomever they may appoint, prior to judging on Tuesday 21 September 2010.
- 346. The procedures for conducting the 24-hour Milk Production Tests are as recommended by the Dairy Goat Society of Australia.
- 347. Exhibitors in the 24-hour Milk Production classes are required to advise the Stewards of:
- a) the number of lactations completed by each Doe,
- b) last date of kidding or abortion.
- 348. Judges have the absolute right to order any Doe competing for Championships to be milked dry before finally awarding the prizes.

SUCKLED KIDS

- 349. Kids not entered for competition will be permitted on the Showgrounds on the provision they are actually being suckled by mothers entered for competition.
- 350. Exhibitors may provide their own mesh or similar, to create their own kid areas within their penning areas, prior to the 24 hour Milk Test and judging day, if required, for kids brought in suckling their dams.

INSPECTION OF EXHIBITS

- 351. Each breed society or association shall put forward nominations for Inspector appointments for their breed and these nominations will be considered by the RASV.
- 352. Every animal exhibited in the Goat section will be subject to inspection carried out by an Inspector appointed by the RASV.
- 353. Without prejudice to any other applicable regulations, if the relevant Inspector determines, or the relevant Inspectors unanimously determine that any animal entered for competition:
- a) is not true to type; or
- b) is not of sufficient merit as to be worthy of exhibition in the class or classes for which it is entered; or
- c) has not been adequately prepared for the Show; or
- d) bears any marking brand or tattoo inconsistent with either the markings brand or tattoo disclosed in the relevant Entry Form or any marking brand or tattoo not in accordance with the records of the relevant Breed Society, then such animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show and the RASV may by notice to the Exhibitor, require the animal to be forthwith removed from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animal and failing such removal by him within the time prescribed by the RASV, the RASV may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall become by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the RASV.

Dairy Goats (Inspection): Saturday 18 September 2010 at 8:00pm

Dairy Goats (Strip Out): Saturday 18 September 2010 at 8:00pm
Dairy Goats (Milk Testing): Sunday 19 September 2010 at 8:00am

and 8:00pm

Dairy Goats (Strip Out): Monday 20 September 2010 at 8:00pm

354. Exhibitors are required to have their stock attended and in readiness for inspection on request.

355. Without prejudice, the determination of the Inspectors or of the Veterinary Surgeons on any matter shall be subject only to appeal to the Chief Steward in the Goat section, who shall make such determinations and directions as he thinks fit, which determinations and directions shall be final and shall not be called into question in any proceedings or in any manner whatsoever. The Inspector, Veterinary Surgeons or Chief Steward shall not be required to furnish to the Exhibitor any reasons for their determination or directions or to give to the Exhibitor any right to be heard on any matter in question.



356. Any animal entered, which can be proved to the satisfaction of the RASV to have received hormones, shall be disqualified. The decision or determination of the RASV shall be final and shall not be called into question in any proceeding or in any manner whatsoever.

TAMPERING OF EXHIBITS

357. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the animal is not subject to prohibited practices, prior to and whilst on the Showgrounds.

358. The RASV may make or cause to be made, any test of any Exhibit to determine whether any drug or other substance has been administered to the Exhibit and may take possession of any such Exhibit for any of the aforesaid purposes and detain such Exhibit for such period as the RASV deems necessary. Procedures for the testing of prohibited substances may include random tests on Exhibits.

359. Should a positive test to a prohibited substance or practice result, any costs associated with testing will be borne by the Exhibitor.

360. In accordance with General Regulation 7.1, should a positive test to a prohibited substance or practice result, the RASV reserves the right to forfeit an award.

JUDGING

361. The following Regulations shall be read subject to Regulations 10.1 through to 11.7 inclusive of the General Regulations.

a). Judging dates of Exhibits are as follows:

Dairy Goats: Tuesday 21 September 2010 from 8:30am

Boer Goats: Tuesday 21 September 2010 from 8:30am

Boer Goat Carcase (Hoof component): Monday 20 September 2010 from 10:30am.

A ribbon may be awarded, at the Judges discretion, to place getters in all classes

b). Exhibitors of goats shall be present at the appropriate Judging Ring at least 15 minutes prior to the time specified in the timetable for judging to take place. They must have their Exhibits ready for judging, and enter the Judging Ring immediately upon request by the appropriate steward(s).

c). Attendants leading goats in the Judging Ring or on parade must wear uniform white coats and the Exhibit number of the goat. Exhibitors must collect these numbers from the Superintendent's Office.

d). Persons in charge of Exhibits at or in the Judging Ring shall not address the Judge unless authorised by the Steward in Charge or the Judge himself.

362. After judging is completed, only prize-winning goats are permitted to take part in parades. All prize-winning Dairy goats must be taken out on parade, in accordance with the printed program. Prize-winning Angoras may also be paraded provided they can be suitably led.

363. In any parade prior to judging, goats are to be paraded according to the following formula:

1-3 head exhibited:

1 head paraded

4-6 head exhibited:

2 head paraded

over 6 head exhibited:

3 head paraded

364. No ribbons will be permitted on the Exhibits on parade, except those won during the 2010 Royal Melbourne Show.

365. Persons in charge of Exhibits must in no circumstance leave their Exhibits unattended at or in the Judging Ring.

RUGGING

366. Exhibits must not be rugged during the hours the Show is open to the public. Exhibitors will be liable to a fine of \$50.00 for every infringement of this regulation.

PRIZES

367. Ribbons may be awarded up to 6th place as follows:

1 to 10 Exhibits per class:

1st, 2nd & 3rd ribbons.

11 to 20 Exhibits per class:

1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th ribbons.

Over 20 Exhibits per class:

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th ribbons.

368. Judging is subject to General Regulation 10. The Judge is under no obligation to award the prizes listed in the table where he considers in his absolute discretion that such prize or prizes are not to be awarded.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

369. Prize money as stated in the relevant Prize Schedule, does not include GST. GST will be added to the Prize money for Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and have provided an ABN Number.
