On the whole the trotters and pacers who entered the judging ring, were a moderate lot, the exception perhaps being the two-year-old filly Kiora Girl, by Pedro Pronto from Brown Ribbon, a mare who, in her racing days recorded 2min. 11sec. for a mile in New Zealand. Under a different judge Kiora Girl won first and champion last year in the class for yearlings, and both adjudicators agreed by their notes that the filly is an especially good one.

Her dam, Brown Ribbon, also shown by the yearling's breeder, Mr, G. Stow, was the only entrant for the class for brood mares. Brown Ribbon owing to permanent injuries to her forelegs resulting from an accident which occurred two or three years back at Epping, failed to impress onlookers, but, as was the case twelve months ago, she won the prize because as a brood mare her injuries did not detract from her value as a brood mare. Summing up the whole of the trotting exhibits Mr. J. James, the judge, said that with the exceptions stated the trotters and pacers were of poor class and mostly on the small side.

A notable achievement was the lowering of the official record for the one mile trot by H. E. Cockayne's Jean Pronto, which covered the distance in fine style in 2min 12secs. This was 1/4sec better than the record time created by Direct Home last year. The unofficial track record is 2min 10 3/4secs established by Happy Voyage in 1921. Although four attempts were made this was not lowered. A special prize of £130 was offered for the trotter which lowered the unofficial record and £75 for the horse breaking the official record.



EVOLUTION OF THE ROYAL MELBOURNE SHOW MILE RECORD

The Time Test for trotters has been a staple of the Royal Melbourne Show since its inception with the circuit on which these tests have been contested having undergone several changes through the years. In was only in 1895 that horses trialled over the exact imperial mile on a circuit that was 550 yards. With the advent of night trotting in 1947 the Showgrounds circuit was upgraded to 660 yards. The records below cover the period from 1895 to 1946.

1931 Royal Agricultural Society Show (September 17 - 26)

The entries for the nine competition ring events consituted a record. In the breeding classes a slight improvement was noted. In the past few years it must have been disheartening for the Society to note the poor nominations on occasions, the only animal entered winning the prize. However, the future looks much brighter and the Society should not consider the deleting of any class for at least another year.

In the square-gaited stallion class, Huon Marvin, now a four-year-old received first and championship honours. This speedy and solidly built trotter has proved himself one of the best juveniles seen on the racing track for years and Mr. T. G. Missen, the owner and breeder, is to be congratulated on possessing such a good horse. Maurite, a half brother to Paddy McKinney, received second prize.

In the pacing section the competition was very keen. Though six entries had been received, Dalla Derby and Barry Boy, both by Globe Derby, were the only ones led into the ring. Mr. Rousch's choice fell on Dalla Derby, the well known performer both free-legged and hoppled. The winner is a horse of commanding appearance and good colour, and the judge spoke in complimentary terms of his general appearance.

Dalla Derby, by the way, was also successfully represented by his progeny in a couple of the juvenile classes. On the Saturday Dalla Derby proved himself a speedy performer by recording a rate of 2m 18 1/2s from a 2.28 mark when successful in the Commonwealth Handicap. After the race Mr. Hec Kendall, the veterinary surgeon, remarked that Dalla Derby was an almost perfect specimen and mated with any class mare could hardly fail to produce a good utility type.

In the brood mare section the entries were light. Brown Ribbon being beaten by Lyndhurst Direct. In the three-yearold colt class there was no entry.

Walla Walla made an attempt to reduce both the official and unofficial records established by Jean Pronto (2m 12s) and Happy Voyage (2m 10 3/4s) respectively.

His reputation and earlier feats at the Show had all trotting enthusiasts keyed up to the highest pitch, and his exhibition was eagerly awaited.

Driven by W. J. "Bill" McKay from a standing start he paced the mile in 2:11 - one second faster than the official record but still one quarter of a second outside the unofficial one.

Walla Walla had the services of two different pacemakers but there did not appear to be the necessary understanding for successful teamwork. Just before the relief galloper took up the running Walla Walla was perceptibly slowing down evidently in keeping with the diminishing speed of the first pacemaker.

According to the driver the failure of Walla Walla to reduce the record by a bigger margin was due to the lack of continuity between the gallopers.

Owing to the attempt being made on the last day of the Show, the great pacer was deprived of a further chance of beating Happy Voyage's 2min 10 3/4s mile.



WALLA WALLA STUNS CROWD IN DEFEAT

Walla Walla, off the back mark of 60 yards, excelled himself in the Final of the "Eagley" Open, when amidst the wildest enthusiasm he averaged a rate of just over 2:10. The official verdict was 8 yards in favour of Jean Pronto (off the front).

A private watch holder made Walla Walla's time 2min 30s which worked down mathematically is about one-ninth of a second over the 2:10 rate. Even allowing a second longer for the journey than the winner's official time Walla Walla actually paced at faster rate than the track's unofficial record time of 2min 10 3/4s put up by Happy Voyage when that great stallion did that time over the exact mile in 1921.

Walla Walla's feat was the more remarkable when it is taken into consideration that he had to go around the field. At one stage he was clocked at a 2min rate and undoubetdly is a wonderful pacer.



1932 Royal Agricultural Society Show (September 15 - 24)

Last year the entries foir the competitive events at the Melbourne Show consituted a record, and this year, the total, though not so high, compared very favourably.

In the judged classes, the competition was keener than usual. Harold Pronto, the well performed and handsome Don Pronto, secured first and champion in the pacing stallion class. Mr. Jack James, the judge, remarked on the improvement in the classes, which he regarded as the best for years.



Considering the very little encouragement to breed trotting and pacing stock in Victoria, the competition at the Melbourne Show in point of numbers must be considered satisfactory.

Mr. W. J. Messenger, the judge appointed from South Australia, was rather critical of the mares and young stock shown, remarking that they were sent into the ring in rough condition. He was, however, in raptures over the two-year-old entire Lee Derby, a son of Globe Derby and Lee White, stating that he was one of the nicest colts he had ever seen.

Last March it will be remembered this pacing aristocrat was sold cheaply for 62 1/2 guineas to the McKay stable. He was bred by Mr. E. Tatlow, who always sends his young stock to market in great condition.. Lee Derby was particularly outstanding and Mr. Tatlow could have got more privately than by auction, that to his credit he did not withhold the colt on the day.

Lady Style, an unperformed mare by All Style from Lady Edna, got the award as a brood mare. She was sold cheaply at Mr. W. Balloch's sale for 14 1/2 guineas being then in foal to Guy Barrister.

Globe Derby stock were well to the fore. Dalla Derby was first and champion, whilst another Globe Derby in Barry Boy was adjudged reserve champion. Mr. Messenger spoke well of the pair and considered that there was little difference, but Dalla Derby's better action turned the scale.

Others by Globe Derby to be successful were New Globe, Star Queen, whilst Derby Way got a second. 





TRAGEDY INSPIRES LEGENDARY "GARRYOWEN" TROPHY



Back in the late 1920s early 1930s, Garryowen was a horse—a horse who won numerous prizes and titles including many of the big show titles at the Royal Melbourne Show. He was owned and ridden by Violet Murrell, who was considered one of the top show riders of her day. One night in 1934, the stables at Violet's home in Mentone, Melbourne, went up in flames and in a desperate attempt to save her beloved Garryowen and other animals, Violet ran into the stables.

Tragically, at the age of 29, she died in the fire and in a second tragedy her husband, Bill, who had tried to help his wife, died a few days later from the injuries he sustained. It was a story that touched the hearts of the Melbourne people, whether they had an interest in horses or not, and the story has lived on in the show class that was named after Violet's horse. Violet Murrell (nee Farmer) was an exceptional equestrienne from primary school age winning hundreds of prizes in riding, dressage and jumping events. She even won an exhibition pony race at Caulfield.

The inaugural winner of the Garryowen Trophy in 1934 was Miss Kitty Sutherland (pictured right) with her horse Jonas.

Another winner of the Garryowen Trophy was Harness Racing Hall of Fame member Patsy Abrahams won the 1962 Garryowen Trophy on her horse Windy Wold.

Subsequently Patsy became one of pioneer women fighting authorities for the right of female participants to be treated equally with men in respect of being licensed to compete in races.



1934 Royal Agricultural Society Centenary Show (October 18 - 27)

The Centenary Show was opened by the H.R.H., the Duke Of Gloucester. The judging of pacers and trotters was done by Mr. J. Munro from N.S.W. Excepting an isolated case the classes filled very well. Mr. Munro remarked that taken all through, they were a fair lot, but he was disappointed by the action of the majority of candidates in the square-gaited class. He especially commented on the 3-year-old Lee Derby and the 2-year-old Miss Keewong.

Lee Globe has a great turn of speed for his age, is in training, but Miss Keewong has not yet been hoppled. Mr Munro said he would be disappointed if Lee Globe and Miss Keewong do not prove to be speedy pacers. The Globe Derby stock did well, the old horse being successfully represented by Dalla Derby, Star Princess, Lee Derby and Lee Globe, whilst Dalla Derby, Globepool and Barry Boy, sons of Globe Derby, also sired winners in the breeding classes.



1936 Royal Agricultural Society Show (September 21 - 30)

The breeding classes so far as trotters and pacers were concerned were rather weak according to judge Mr. Jack James. Roy Redmond USA was the only aged trotting stallion entered and rather to the general surprise was beaten by the winner in the 3-year-old class for the Championship. This was Globepool's Image, a big colt by Globepool from an unnamed Bronte mare out of a First Voyage mare. Last year Globepool's Image won the 2-year-old class.

In the pacing stallion class Lee Derby (first and champion) beat his full brother Lee Globe, Dalla Derby getting third prize. Globe Derby figured as the sire of each of the trio and progeny of his sons (Globepool, Dalla Derby and Northwood Derby) were also represented. Others by Globe Derby to secure awards were the full sisters Star Princess and Star Countess.

A feature of the racing was that on the nine events contested, Globe Derby line horses won eight - Globe Derby sired Lee Derby, Smiling Derby; Dalla Derby (by Globe Derby) sired Miss Keewong, Black Panther and Hilda Dalla; Walla Walla (by Globe Derby) sired Our Walla; New Derby (by Globe Derby) sired New Ideal; The Fence (by Globe Derby) sired The Gap. Globe Derby did not have a starter in the remaining event for trotters, won by Bell Age, a son of Australia's premier trotting sire First Voyage.



1937 - THE FIRST ROYAL SHOW AT NIGHT

For the first time in its history the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Is holding night sessions of its annual show this year. In addition to the customary nine days, the show will be opened on five nights. The duration of the show will be from Thursday, September 23, to Saturday week, October 2, and the night sessions will be on Saturday next and the following Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. In introducing night sessions of Its show the R.A.S.V. is following a practice already adopted at the annual agricultural shows at Sydney, Brisbane and Adelaide. An elaborate system of flood lighting for the arena has been installed at the show grounds to enable the night programme ot sporting events to be carried out.

Under this new system of lighting the arena proper is flood-lit from five lattice towers, each 110 feet high, standing at intervals round the outer boundary. Each tower carries a battery of 25 projectors, and each projector has a lamp ot 1,000 watt capacity, the full stream of lighting being the equivalent of 30,000,000 candle beams, in addition to this flood of light over the arena, an independent system of lighting for the trotting track Is provided from a ring of electric lamps, each of 750 watt capacity, suspended at a height of 19 feet from rolled steel standards just outside the arena fence, at intervals of 22 1/2 feet.

These lighting systems can be operated together or Independently, and it is claimed that the Melbourne showground now has the best lit arena in Australia. The steel lattice towers have been built by a Melbourne engineering firm, and the projectors have been supplied by a British electrical company. The towers are supplied with electric current through a sub station, which has been erected by the society on the Langs road frontage of the show ground. Additional lighting has been provided also at pavilions, halls and stands, as well as at the sideshow area, so that the whole of the show can be seen to full advantage by night as well as by day. It is stated that during the past twelve months the society has spent between £9,000 and £10,000 on improvements, the major portion of the money having been expended on lighting. The night programmes will include trotting, chariot racing, steer riding, high jumping and other gymkhana events.

Prize money, totalling £1,300 and an excellent programme which gives the better class horses ample opportunities of racing have drawn horses to Melbourne would do credit to an Inter-Dominion championship meeting. NomInations, too, are easily a record - more than 400 this year compared to 180 last year.

The special trotting sub-committee responsible for the improvement consisted of Messrs. Harry A. Anderson (Geelong), H. Lyall (North Melbourne) and A. G. Hunter (Seymour), of the committee of the R.A.S., and Messrs. V. Dullard, W. McKay and A. J. Gray (the trotting handicapper), whose services were co-opted by the society.



1937 Royal Agricultural Society Show (Sept. 23 - Oct. 2)

With its cheering spectators thronging the fences and occupying practically every available seat In the stands, the Royal Agricultural Society's triumph, with the inauguration of night ring events on Saturday, was incidentally a striking demonstration of the popularity of night trotting, as the crowd enthusiastically applauded the eight heats and the finals of the two trotting events decided.

The breeding classes at the Melbourne Show this year filled fairly well and competition in the stallion classes were particularly keen. In the trotting class the imported Peterwah was adjudged by Mr. B. O'Sullivan as first and champion, whilst another importation Roy Redmond got second prize as well as reserve champion. Globepool's Image, first and champion last year, was awarded third prize.

Van Derby brought over from Tasmania by Mr. E. Tatlow beat imported Louis Direct (second) and Almont Wilkes in the pacing class. The 5-year-old son of Globe Derby and Roselawn (dam of Lawn Derby), is a very handsome brown, and was awarded the championship ribbon. Owing to some confusion Louis Direct was not brought into the ring for the reserve championship which was awarded to Mr. Diskin's nice 3-year-old colt James McElwyn, by Nelson McElwyn from Lottie Voyage, whose dam is a half sister to Happy Voyage.

Van Derby not only excelled in the ring but also in the arena, winning an alltime record eight times without defeat, two events that consisted of heat, semi and Final and another that had just a heat and final. In each race Van Derby was handled by his owner-breeder Mr. E. Tatlow.



Though Lawn Derby did a 2min 3 2/5 in a special exhibition mile on the Wednesday night without the hopples this did not entitle him to the £50 prize for breaking Auburn Lad's record of 2min 08 1/4s which was done from a standing start. In 1936 the Melbourne Show authorities allowed a flying start, but Auburn Lad's record still stood.

However, on the Saturday, it was twice broken. From a flying start Logan Derby did 2min 7 1/2s but his record was short-lived with the peerless Lawn Derby appeared on the scene. Apparently loafing the first half, a bit more speed was clapped on in the second half, and it was a very strenuous effort that reduced the official record to 2min 4 3/5s.

It was the intention of Jack O'Shea to again drive the horse unhoppled, but the rough state of the track was the deciding factor in the use of hopples.





The success of trotting under lights at the 1937 Royal Agricultural Show was palpable with breeders, owners, trainers, drivers and the general public eagerly awaiting the 1938 Show programme which they embraced enthusiastically in record numbers.

Twenty one (21) events were programmed - 11 during the day and 10 at night - and that figure mushroomed into an incredible 122 heats, semis and Finals being contested - 68 during the day and 54 at night. Two races, the Orlando Handicap and the October Handicap took ten clashes to decide the winner, however, the most popular was the Victoria Handicap run under lights that encompassed 13 contests to decide the winner.

Competition was not quite as keen in the breeding classes, with the unraced Globepool's Image being successful in the trotting stallion class being first and champion. In the pacing class a four-year-old in New Lulu gained similar awards, and bigger than the general run of Lulu Boy's progeny, will later develop into a beautiful horse. He is out of a full sister to New Derby, last year's Grand Champion.





Judge of the trotters was Mr. Louis Robertson, who was one of the most successful reinsmen in New Zealand and Australia years age. Twenty-five years ago he forsook the harness horse, and became a lending trainer of thoroughbreds, turning out the winners of innumerable races from the Melbourne Cup and Victoria Derby downwards. Mr. Robertson has not lost his eye for the trotting horse. After he had finished his adjudications he was asked for his opinion as to the class of the trotting stock that had come before him. His reply was emphatic and laconic — "very bad."

Of the three colts entered for the two-year-old class, Norman Newport's Van Derby colt, Van Logan, bred in Tasmania by Mr. E. Tatlow, was placed first. In the yearling colt class there were four entrants. Mr. Robertson placed Grattanwah first, but did not consider any of the others worthy of second or even third money.

Tasmanlan bred Star Princess, a strongly built mare bred in Tasmania by Mr. Tatlow, and shown by W. J. McKay, stood out from the opposition in the brood mare, foaled or in foal, class. All the seven two-year-old fillies nominated entered the ring, and W. J. McKay, a great enthusiast where trotting and show-ring horses are concerned, gained his second success of the day, his Lee Globe filly gaining a narrow decision from W. W. Sime's Valma Times.

So far as action in the arena, a total of 20 races were programmed and they produced 112 racing contests, 36 during the day and 76 at night, including the Victoria Handicap that consisted of 10 heats, two semi-finals and a Final.


